

- **5.** NCCU went 7-9 in conference play last year. **SCOUTING THE WILDCATS:**

Bethune-Cookman is currently 4-9 in MEAC play, and have won its last two games, both at home. The Wildcats are led by one of the league's top scorers in Brandon Tabb, averaging 18.5 points per game. Tabb put in 22 points in the B-CU's last game, a 75-65 win over Norfolk State. NCCU split the series with B-CU last year, winning at home and losing in Daytona Beach, Fla. in the final meeting of the season. This is the only Monday, Nov. 28 after a strong four-game stretch scheduled meeting between his season.

SCOUTING THE TIGERS:

Savannah State is 7-6 in the MEAC entering the weekend, and the Tigers are the highest scoring team in the league, at about 84.8 points per contest, but have dropped their last four games. Troyce Manassa is within the top-10 in scoring in the conference with 16.6 points per game for the Parick Cole made history when he recorded Tigers. Manassas poured in 22 points in the last the first triple-double in the Division-I era for game for the Tigers, an 84-83 loss at Coppin State.

FLYING HIGH IN THE MEAC

NCCU sits in the top-four of every MEAC stat category except for one, and within the individual and 11 assists, making both players the first with stat categories over 20 spots are taken up by Eagles. As a team, the Eagles are first in four separate categories.

HELPER, HELPER

Senior quards Patrick Cole and Dajuan Graf have been scoring the ball well this season, but they have also gotten their teammates involved as the top two assisters in the MEAC. Cole is first with 5.6 per game, followed by Graf at 4.9.

WINDOW WASHERS

NCCU pulled down an incredible 56 rebounds against Montreat, with 26 offensive boards and 30 defensive caroms. That stacks up as the second-most rebounds in a game in the Division-I era for the Eagles, behind 57 against Barber-Scotia on Dec. 17, 2014.

HOW CAN I ASSIST YOU?

Senior guard Patrick Cole dished out a career-high 13 assists against LIU Brooklyn, tied for the fifthmost in a single game alongside Nimrod Hilliard (at ETSU, Jan. 31, 2015) and all-time assists leader Emanuel Chapman (vs. Coppin State Jan. 26, 2013). Cole is currenly ranked in the Top-25 in assists the NCAA Division-I with 5.8 assists per game as of Feb. 17.

GOING BACK-TO-BACK...X2

Patrick Cole became the first two-time and back-to-back recipient of the MEAC Player of the Week honor from both the conference and College Sports Madness in the 2016-17 season on from Nov. 14 to Nov. 26 with 23.0 points, 8.0 rebounds and 6.8 assists per game. Cole again earned back-to-back MEAC Player of the Week honors on Feb.13 after averaging 24.8 points, 6.0 rebounds and 5.5 assists over four games from Jan. 30 to Feb. 11.

TRIPLE, DOUBLE

NCCU with 14 points, 12 rebounds and 10 assists against Jackson State. Dajuan Graf picked up a double-double in the same game with 15 points double-digit assists since the 2014-15 season.

Junior forward Pablo Rivas matched a rare feat of former Eagle Dominique Sutton against Western Carolina on Nov. 16, as he went 7-for-7 from the floor and 2-for-2 from the free throw line for 18 points and nine rebounds. He is the only other Eagle besides Emmanuel Chapman to shoot 100% from the floor with a spotless three-point percentage as well. Rivas shot 100% from the floor a second time at Missouri, but missed one free throw for 16 points and six rebounds (6-6 FG. 4-5 FT).

NCCU VOTED FOURTH IN MEAC PRESEASON POLL. COLE SEC-OND TEAM

North Carolina Central University was voted fourth in the preseason poll by the league coaches and sports information directors. NCCU received 234 total points in the poll, and Patrick Cole (Newark, N.J.) was voted to the Second Team.

ABOUT THE 2015-16 SEASON

- -NCCU went 8-5 at McDougald-McLendon Now that NCCU is back and established in Arena, securing its seventh consecutive winning season at home.
- Led by returner Rashaun Madison, NCCU topped the MEAC in three-point percentage with 34.8 percent of attempts made.
- -NCCU once again was one of the best defensive teams in the league, allowing just 69.8 points per game, good for second in the conference.

THE NEW NEST

McDougald-McLendon Arena received some renovations during the offseason before the 2015-16 season, and now boasts the most biomechanically-sophisticated maple sports floor system in the state of North Carolina. The facility also received high-efficiency LED lights from Cree, Inc. as part of a UNC system-wide project, and has a center-hung Daktronics videoboard. NATION'S SECOND-LONGEST HOME WIN STREAK

NCCU held a 38-game home win streak, which ranked second in Division I behind Arizona. The Eagles had not lost at home since Dec. 4, 2012 (Eastern Kentucky, 57-63). The last MEAC team to beat NCCU in Durham was Savannah State on Feb. 11, 2012 (67-57) before Howard ended the streak on Dec. 7, 2015 (71-69). NCCU defeated 26 consecutive conference opponents during the run.

WE MUST PROTECT THE NEST

During the 2013-14 season, North Carolina Central University went unbeaten at home going 14-0, marking that feat for the first time since the 1997-98 campaign. The Eagles have now gone undefeated at home in consecutive seasons for the first time in school history.

Eagles Hold Off Hawks Late

PRINCESS ANNE, Md. – North Carolina Central University held on late and made its free throws down the stretch to get past Maryland Eastern Shore for its 11th consecutive win, 82-69 at the Hytche Athletic Center on Saturday, Feb. 18.

With the win, NCCU (20-6, 11-1 MEAC) secured its 19th 20-win season in program history, and its fourth under head coach LeVelle Moton.

NCCU went on a 12-0 run to open the contest as Dajuan Graf [Charlotte, N.C.] and Rashaun Madison [Norfolk, Va.] hit a pair of momentum threes, but MDES [9-18, 6-6 MEAC] was quick to respond. The Eagles led 26-16 at the 7:14 mark in the half, but the Hawks closed the period on a 17-9 run to capture a two-point lead at the intermission, 35-33.

The Eagles found their gear after the break, as Madison came out firing to make his first three three-point attempts in the period, and Cole tacked on another as NCCU started the half on a strong run, and led by as many as 19 in the second half. However, the second half mirrored the first with the Hawks applying pressure down the stretch and cut the lead to as little as six within the final two minutes, at 73-67 with 1:54 to go.

The Eagles were able to make their free throws down the stretch, along with two makes from Cole at the line after a critical technical foul against MDES in the final minute, and NCCU also held the Hawks scoreless in the final 1:16 to secure the victory.

For the third time in the last four games, NCCU shot over 50 percent from the floor, making 55.1 percent of its shots, and was over 40 percent from the arc at 41.7 percent.

Cole notched his sixth career double-double with 17 points and 10 rebounds along with a joint game-high six assists, and Madison finished with 18 points as he rained in six treys for the sixth time in his career.

Del'vin Dickerson (Houston, Texas) was a perfect 7-for-7 from the floor and made his only free throw attempt for 15 points with four boards. Graf was the fourth Eagle in double-digits with 15 points and a joint game-high six helpers and five rebounds.

Dontae Caldwell (Santa Ana, Calif.) had a game-high 19 points for the Hawks with seven rebounds, and Bakari Copeland (Decatur, Ga.) was close behind with 15 points. Isaac Taylor (Wachapreague, Va.) was the third Hawk with double-figure points with 10 and five boards.

Eagles Survive Scare from Bison

WASHINGTON, D.C. – North Carolina Central University once again had to make its free throws down the stretch to survive a nail biter, this time a 66-59 victory against Howard for a 12th straight win at Burr Gymnasium, on Monday, Feb. 20.

NCCU [20-6, 12-1] started the game on a 9-2 run, and then used strong rebounding to help establish a lead in the early going of the game. Rashaun Madison (Norfolk, Va.) got going early for the Eagles as he nailed a pair of triples in the first frame, and Patrick Cole (Newark, N.J.) was also rolling with nine points and six rebounds for the maroon and gray. NCCU led 39-29 at the half, and held a 24-21 rebounding advantage.

Howard (7-21, 4-9) was up for the task in the first half however, as Solomon Mangham (Stone Mountain, Ga.) stepped up to knock down three treys in the first half to keep the Bison close, as he finished the half with 11 points and six rebounds.

NCCU led by as many as 13 in the second half, but the Bison went on a surge midway through the period, and knotted the game at 56 and then took their first lead of the game, 58-56 with 7:10 to play. The Eagles were able to clamp down from there and go on an 8-1 run to close the game with some clutch free throws to pull out the win.

Cole finished with his second consecutive double-double with 17 points and 11 rebounds, and Dajuan Graf (Charlotte, N.C.) flirted with a triple-double with 17 points, eight rebounds and seven assists. Madison finished 11 points, and Del'vin Dickerson (Houston, Texas) was the fourth Eagle in double-digits with 10 points and seven boards. Kyle Benton (Long Beach, Calif.) did not score, but he did contribute a strong defensive performance with nine rebounds.

Mangham was the go-to man for Howard as he finished with a double-double by collecting a team-high 16 points and 10 boards, and Charles Williams (Richmond, Va.) finished with 12 points and six rebounds. Tyler Stone (Toronto, Canada) also was close to a double-double with 10 points and eight rebounds.

On March 25, 2009, arguably one of the greatest players in school history was elevated from Assistant Coach to the position of Head Coach, becoming the 17th to be named in that spot in the program's history

Close to 25 years after the magical run of the 1989 NCAA Division II National Championship team, and just 10 days shy of the fifth anniversary of the day of his official hiring, NCCU soared to its first MEAC Tournament Championship on March 15, 2014 following its 71-62 victory over Morgan State in front of a near-capacity crowd inside the Norfolk Scope Arena. The 2013-14 Eagles tied a school record in wins (28), won the most games in a season for any squad in MEAC history, and was the lowest seed for any league champion in the NCAA Tournament as the maroon and gray earned a 14seed in the East Region. Moton's squad finished 15-1 in conference play earning the school's first Division I regular season title and won 20 straight contests, which set a new NCAA Division I level record for the program.

The following year, his sixth season as head coach at NCCU. Moton guided the 2014-15 Fagles to a 25-8 overall record, including a 19-3 mark during the final three-and-a-half months, as well as the school's first appearance in the National Invitation Tournament. The 2014-15 squad made history by becoming the first men's basketball team in school history to post an unbeaten regularseason conference record at 16-0 to repeat as MEAC regular-season champions. The Eagles were among the top five defenses in Division I, ranking second in field goal percentage defense (behind Kentucky), fourth in three-point field goal percentage defense and fifth in scoring defense. NCCU completed the campaign by extending the second-longest home win streak in Division I at 35 victories in-a-row (behind Arizona).

Moton joined hall of fame coach John McLendon and national championship coach Michael Bernard as the only coaches in NCCU men's basketball history to lead the Eagles to three straight 20-win seasons. As a credit to the program's recent success, NCCU boasts the best regular-season conference record during the last three seasons at 46-2, a winning percentage of .958.

With the rings of a champion came the accolades as Moton earned MEAC Coach of the Year honors, MEAC Tournament's Most Outstanding Coach award, and was named the BoxtoRow.com HBCU National Coach of the Year, while earning finalist spots in the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year Award (Top-Mid-Major Coach), and the Top Minority Coach honor, the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Award.

The maroon and gray's second season in the MEAC, Moton's fourth, was the coming out party for the program. For the first time at the NCAA Division I level, the Eagles won 20 games finishing the year 22-9, and went 15-1 in conference play to earn the No. 2 seed in the conference tournament. Moton earned national praise by being named a finalist for the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Award, and the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year of Award, along with Co-Coach of the Year in the MEAC by CollegeInsider.com.

In his third season in charge of NCCU, Moton took his team to a place not since seen since the 2004-05 season when the Eagles finished with a winning record (17-15) and were seeded fifth in their first MEAC Tournament at the Division I level.

His second year at the helm his squad showed the Eagle Nation how bright the future was as his squad racked up 15 wins and recorded the first non-losing season in nearly six years. He earned NCAA Division I Independent Coach of the Year honors.

He initially returned to his alma mater as assistant men's basketball coach in July 2007.

The Hall-of-Famer joined the NCCU staff after serving as head boys basketball coach at Sanderson High School in his hometown of Raleigh, N.C. During his three-year tenure (2004-07) at Sanderson, Moton led the Spartans to an overall record of 59-25, while winning back-to-back Cap-7 tournament championships in 2006 and 2007.

A 1996 graduate of NCCU with a bachelor's degree in recreation administration, Moton became the school's third all-time leading scorer with 1,714 points during his historic hardwood career as an Eagle from 1992-96, earning the nickname "Poetry `n Moton."

During his junior and senior seasons, Moton was voted All-CIAA First Team, NCAA Division II

South Atlantic All-Region First Team and NCAA Division II All-America Honorable Mention. He was named the 1996 CIAA (Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association) Men's Basketball Player of the Year and was inducted into the NCCU Athletic Hall of Fame in 2004.

Among NCCU's all-time career leaders, Moton ranks first in 3-point field goals made (213 of 529), third in scoring (1,714 points), fourth in free throws made (363 of 467), fifth in assists (278), eighth in field goals made (569 of 1,159), 10th in scoring average (16.6 points per game), and 11th in steals (110)

As a junior (1994-95), he topped the CIAA and was No. 16 in NCAA Division II in scoring with an average of 23.5 points per game. His 87 made three-point field goals that year remains the school's single-season record

As a senior (1995-96), he placed second in the CIAA with 21.3 points per game and ranked among the conference's top 10 statistical leaders in assists, free throw percentage and 3-point field goal percentage.

Moton played on three CIAA Southern Division Championship teams and made two trips to the NCAA playoffs, including an NCAA Division II South Atlantic Regional Championship title in 1993. After NCCU, Moton played four years of professional basketball in Indonesia (1996-97) and Israel (1998-99). Throughout his professional playing career, Moton averaged 25.0 points per contest, and dished out a little more than five assists per game as a pro-

He was head coach at West Millbrook Middle School for three seasons (2001-04) before taking over the Sanderson boys basketball program in 2004.

Moton is a 1992 graduate of Enloe High School in Raleigh, N.C., where he was named Cap5 Player of the Year as a senior.

In December of 2013, Moton received his Master's degree in Special Education with a focus on Learning Disabilities

LEVELLE MOTON: THE PLAYER
