

STARTING FIVE:

4-2 is NCCU's best November since the Eagles went 5-1 during the 2013-14 season.
 NCCU leads the MEAC in field goal percentage at 47.1.

3. NCCU will be on the road for six of the next 10 games from Nov. 26 to Dec. 30.

4. NCCU's non-conference schedule puts the Eagles on the road nine times out of 14 games.
5. NCCU went 5-9 in non-conference play last year.

SCOUTING THE WARRIORS:

Southern Wesleyan comes to Durham with a 1-5 record, and have dropped the last four games. The Warriors are led by senior guard Darius Sharpe who is lighting up opponents for 23.3 points per outing. Last time out he poured in 26 points in an 81-65 loss to Anderson on Nov. 28.

SCOUTING THE PIRATES:

East Carolina is off to a blistering start to the season, sporting a 6-2 record, and the Pirates are coming off back-to-back wins. Andre Washington is averaging close to a double-double per game with 10.0 points and 8.1 rebounds per competition for the Pirates, and he put up 13 points and eight rebounds against Hampton in a 68-48 win.

NCCU vs CONFERENCE CAROLINAS

Conference Carolinas is a Division II league that features 11 institutions, and the Eagles are 6-4 all-time against the conference. NCCU's most recent matchup with Conference Carolinas was Nov. 29, 2011 when the Eagles defeated Southern Wesleyan 94-60 in Durham.

NCCU vs AMERICAN ATHLETIC CONFERENCE

NCCU has played six of the 12 current members of the American Athletic Conference, and the Eagles are 0-12 against the league. NCCU most recently visited Houston during the Global Sports Classic in the 2015-16 season, and fell 73-65.

GOING BACK-TO-BACK

Patrick Cole became the first two-time and back-to-back recipient of the MEAC Player of the Week honor from both the conference and College Sports Madness in the 2016-17 season on Monday, Nov. 28 after a strong four-game stretch from Nov. 14 to Nov. 26 with 23.0 points, 8.0 rebounds and 6.8 assists per game.

BLOCK PARTY

The Eagles protected the paint on the road at Missouri as NCCU recorded eight blocks, tied for the seventh-most in a game in the Division-I era. Will Ransom swatted four by himself, which is tied for the third-most in a game in the same time frame.

TRIPLE, DOUBLE

Parick Cole made history when he recorded the first triple-double in the Division-I era for NCCU with 14 points, 12 rebounds and 10 assists against Jackson State. Dajuan Graf picked up a double-double in the same game with 15 points and 11 assists, making both players the first with double-digit assists since the 2014-15 season.

100%

Junior forward Pablo Rivas matched a rare feat of former Eagle Dominique Sutton against Western Carolina on Nov. 16, as he went 7-for-7 from the floor and 2-for-2 from the free throw line for 18 points and nine rebounds. He is the only other Eagle besides Emmanuel Chapman to shoot 100% from the floor with a spotless three-point percentage as well. Rivas shot 100% from the floor a second time at Missouri, but missed one free throw for 16 points and six rebounds (6-6 FG, 4-5 FT).

STEALING THE SHOW

Redshirt senior guard Patrick Cole showcased his skills on national televion as he poured in 26 points for the Eagles against Ohio State on ESPNU on Monday, Nov. 14. Cole knocked down three treys and also contributed six rebounds and six assists.

NCCU VOTED FOURTH IN MEAC PRESEASON POLL, COLE SEC-OND TEAM

North Carolina Central University was voted fourth in the preseason poll by the league coaches and sports information directors. NCCU received 234 total points in the poll, and Patrick Cole (Newark, N.J.) was voted to the Second Team.

ABOUT THE 2015-16 SEASON

-NCCU went 8-5 at McDougald-McLendon Arena, securing its seventh consecutive winning season at home.

- Led by returner Rashaun Madison, NCCU topped the MEAC in three-point percentage with 34.8 percent of attempts made. -NCCU once again was one of the best defensive teams in the league, allowing just 69.8 points per game, good for second in the conference.

THE NEW NEST

McDougald-McLendon Arena received some renovations during the offseason before the 2015-16 season, and now boasts the most biomechanically-sophisticated maple sports floor system in the state of North Carolina. The facility also received high-efficiency LED lights from Cree, Inc. as part of a UNĆ system-wide project, and has a center-hung Daktronics videoboard. NATION'S SECOND-LONGEST HOME WIN STREAK

NCCU held a 38-game home win streak, which ranked second in Division I behind Arizona. The Eagles had not lost at home since Dec. 4, 2012 (Eastern Kentucky, 57-63). The last MEAC team to beat NCCU in Durham was Savannah State on Feb. 11, 2012 (67-57) before Howard ended the streak on Dec. 7, 2015 (71-69). NCCU defeated 26 consecutive conference opponents during the run.

WE MUST PROTECT THE NEST

During the 2013-14 season, North Carolina Central University went unbeaten at home going 14-0, marking that feat for the first time since the 1997-98 campaign. The seasons. Eagles have now gone undefeated at home in consecutive seasons for the first time in school history.

Eagles Sail past Northern Kentucky

HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, Ky. – North Carolina Central University senior guard Patrick Cole (Newark, N.J.) recorded multiple double digit categories for the second-straight game with 32 points and 10 rebounds to help the Eagles to a tough 82-74 win over Northern Kentucky University on Saturday, Nov. 26 at BB&T Arena.

NKU (3-3) bolted ahead of NCCU (3-2) early in the contest as they put together a 10-2 run to lead by as many as nine at 17-8 with over 12 minutes to play. From there the Eagle defense kicked in to not only take the lead, but hold NKU scoreless for the final six and a half minutes of the first period to lead 42-29 at the break.

Cole continued his hot shooting as he picked up 15 points in the first period along with five rebounds and three assists. The Eagles strung together 20 consecutive points bridging the intermission, but NKU came storming back into the game, cutting the lead to four at 53-49 midway through the second half.

Cole teamed up with Dajuan Graf (Charlotte, N.C.) to help propel the Eagles forward as Graf scored 11 of his 17 points in the second half.

The finale of the contest was tightly contested as Drew McDonald (Cold Spring, Ky.) and Lavone Holland II (Louisville, Ky.) combined for strong finishes down the stretch. McDonald picked up 13 of his joint team-high 20 in the second half and Holland scored 10 of his 20 after the break.

However, the Eagles were able to hold off NKU's charge, and an emphatic windmill from Pablo Rivas (Phoenix, Ariz.) put a cap on an 82-74 win for NCCU. Rivas finished the contest with 13 points and seven boards for the maroon and gray.

Eagles Lead Tigers Wire-To-Wire for Fourth Straight Win

COLUMBIA, Mo. – North Carolina Central University closed out November with a wire-to-wire win over the University of Missouri for a 62-52 win, the Eagles' first over an Southeastern Conference (SEC) opponent in the program's history on Monday, Nov. 28 at Mizzou Arena.

The Eagles have now won four straight to close the month of November.

The first half of the contest moved very slowly as both teams did not shoot too efficiently from the field. NCCU (4-2) made eight of 29 shots, and Mizzou (3-3) was six of 35, including nine missed shot attempts on the same possession within the first 50 seconds of the contest.

The Eagles scored first and held a lead going to the break with help from Patrick Cole (Newark, N.J.) who dropped in 11 points along with six rebounds in the first 20 minutes. Cole finished the game with multiple double-digit categories for the third-straight game with a double-double with 17 points and 12 rebounds, and he tacked on seven assists.

There was strong defensive play in the paint from both teams in the first period, as NCCU swatted seven shot attempts, and Mizzou put away four. Will Ransom (Fort Worth, Texas) led the effort with three blocked shots, followed by Pablo Rivas (Phoenix, Ariz.) who had two. Michael Wolfe (Germantown, Md.) and Cole had one each. Ransom finished the game with 10 rebounds and four blocked shots in a phenomenal defensive performance.

On the other end of the floor, all four blocks were collected by Willie Jackson (Cleveland, Ohio).

The Eagles held a 24-20 lead at the break and kept that lead all the way through to the conclusion, holding off multiple surges from the Tigers for a 62-52 win.

For the second time this year, Rivas was 100 percent from the floor as he shot 6-for-6, and only missed one free throw for 16 points and six rebounds. Dajuan Graf (Charlotte, N.C.) also was a major contributor with 12 points and six rebounds.

On March 25, 2009, arguably one of the greatest players in school history was elevated from Assistant Coach to the position of Head Coach, becoming the 17th to be named in that spot in the program's history.

Close to 25 years after the magical run of the 1989 NCAA Division II National Championship team, and just 10 days shy of the fifth anniversary of the day of his official hiring, NCCU soared to its first MEAC Tournament Championship on March 15, 2014 following its 71-62 victory over Morgan State in front of a near-capacity crowd inside the Norfolk Scope Arena. The 2013-14 Eagles tied a school record in wins (28), won the most games in a season for any squad in MEAC history, and was the lowest seed for any league champion in the NCAA Tournament as the maroon and gray earned a 14seed in the East Region. Moton's squad finished 15-1 in conference play earning the school's first Division I regular season title and won 20 straight contests, which set a new NCAA Division I level record for the program.

The following year, his sixth season as head coach at NCCU, Moton guided the 2014-15 Eagles to a 25-8 overall record, including a 19-3 mark during the final three-and-a-half months, as well as the school's first appearance in the National Invitation Tournament. The 2014-15 squad made history by becoming the first men's basketball team in school history to post an unbeaten regular-season conference record at 16-0 to repeat as MEAC regular-season champions. The Eagles were among the top five defenses in Division I, ranking second in field goal percentage defense (behind Kentucky), fourth in three-point field goal percentage defense and fifth in scoring defense. NCCU completed the campaign by extending the second-longest home win streak in Division I at 35 victories in-a-row (behind Arizona).

Moton joined hall of fame coach John McLendon and national championship coach Michael Bernard as the only coaches in NCCU men's basketball history to lead the Eagles to three straight 20-win seasons. As a credit to the program's recent success, NCCU boasts the best regular-season conference record during the last three seasons at 46-2, a winning percentage of .958.

With the rings of a champion came the accolades as Moton earned MEAC Coach of the Year honors, MEAC Tournament's Most Outstanding Coach award, and was named the BoxtoRow.com HBCU National Coach of the Year, while earning finalist spots in the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year Award (Top-Mid-Major Coach), and the Top Minority Coach honor, the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Award.

The maroon and gray's second season in the MEAC, Moton's fourth, was the coming out party for the program. For the first time at the NCAA Division I level, the Eagles won 20 games finishing the year 22-9, and went 15-1 in conference play to earn the No. 2 seed in the conference tournament. Moton earned national praise by being named a finalist for the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Award, and the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year of Award, along with Co-Coach of the Year in the MEAC by CollegeInsider.com.

In his third season in charge of NCCU, Moton took his team to a place not since seen since the 2004-05 season when the Eagles finished with a winning record (17-15) and were seeded fifth in their first MEAC Tournament at the Division I level.

His second year at the helm his squad showed the Eagle Nation how bright the future was as his squad racked up 15 wins and recorded the first non-losing season in nearly six years. He earned NCAA Division I Independent Coach of the Year honors.

He initially returned to his alma mater as assistant men's basketball coach in July 2007. The Hall-of-Famer joined the NCCU staff after serving as head boys basketball coach at

Sanderson High School in his hometown of Raleigh, N.C. During his three-year tenure (2004-07) at Sanderson, Moton led the Spartans to an overall record of 59-25, while winning back-to-back Cap-7 tournament championships in 2006 and 2007.

A 1996 graduate of NCCU with a bachelor's degree in recreation administration, Moton became the school's third all-time leading scorer with 1,714 points during his historic hardwood career as an Eagle from 1992-96, earning the nickname "Poetry `n Moton."

During his junior and senior seasons, Moton was voted All-CIAA First Team, NCAA Division II

South Atlantic All-Region First Team and NCAA Division II All-America Honorable Mention. He was named the 1996 CIAA (Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association) Men's Basketball Player of the Year and was inducted into the NCCU Athletic Hall of Fame in 2004.

Among NCCU's all-time career leaders, Moton ranks first in 3-point field goals made (213 of 529), third in scoring (1,714 points), fourth in free throws made (363 of 467), fifth in assists (278), eighth in field goals made (569 of 1,159), 10th in scoring average (16.6 points per game), and 11th in steals (110).

As a junior (1994-95), he topped the CIAA and was No. 16 in NCAA Division II in scoring with an average of 23.5 points per game. His 87 made three-point field goals that year remains the school's single-season record.

As a senior (1995-96), he placed second in the CIAA with 21.3 points per game and ranked among the conference's top 10 statistical leaders in assists, free throw percentage and 3-point field goal percentage.

Moton played on three CIAA Southern Division Championship teams and made two trips to the NCAA playoffs, including an NCAA Division II South Atlantic Regional Championship title in 1993.

After NCCU, Moton played four years of professional basketball in Indonesia (1996-97) and Israel (1998-99). Throughout his professional playing career, Moton averaged 25.0 points per contest, and dished out a little more than five assists per game as a pro-

He was head coach at West Milbrook Middle School for three seasons (2001-04) before taking over the Sanderson boys basketball program in 2004.

Moton is a 1992 graduate of Enloe High School in Raleigh, N.C., where he was named Cap5 Player of the Year as a senior.

In December of 2013, Moton received his Master's degree in Special Education with a focus on Learning Disabilities.

He and his wife, Bridget, married on June 28, 2008. They have two children Brooke and LeVelle Jr.




