

#### **SCOUTING THE PATRIOTS:**

George Mason is currently 3-1 at home at Ea-George Mason is currently 3-1 at nome at EagleBank Arena, having been recently defeated by William & Mary 77-70. Jaire Grayer had a breakout performance in the last game with 24 points and seven rebounds, and teammate Otis Livingston II contributed 20 points and five assists. Livingston currently leads the Patriots with 15.4 points and 5.1 assists per game. with 15.4 points and 5.1 assists per game.

#### **SCOUTING THE ANTELOPES:**

Grand Canyon is yet to leave the city of Phoenix, and the Antelope's have opened 5-1 at home in GCU Arena. GCU is spearheaded by Joshua Braun who is averaging 15.1 points and 3.6 rebounds per game. Casey Benson runs the offense with 4.7 assists per game along with 12.0 points per contest.

#### **NEXT MAN UP**

NCCU is one of less than 10 schools that returns zero starters from its previous season. The Eagles bring back the second-fewest starts in the nation with 11, all coming from C.J. Wiggins, and the third-fewest total minutes with 862, 626 of which came from Pablo Rivas.

#### **CRASHING THE BOARDS**

NCCU pulled down the most rebounds in the Division-I era against Warren Wilson when the Eagles swept up 66 rebounds. The Eagles topped the mark of 57 set against Barber-Scotia on Dec. 17, 2014. This season, the Eagles also pulled down 58 boards against Christendom on Dec. 30.

and the Eagles have only faced three: Davidson, Duquesne, and VCU. NCCU is 0-3 all-time against the A-10, and haven't faced a confernce member since Dec. 22, 2008 when the Eagles lost 79-97

The Western Athletic Conference is an eight-team conference, and NCCU has played three: Chicago State, Texas-Rio Grande Valley and Utah Valley. The Eagles hold a 3-6 all-time record against the WAC, and most recently defeated Utah Valley, 73-67 on the road on Dec. 22, 2012.

Larry McKnight, Jr. was highly efficient from the floor at Marshall as he was 7-for-7 from the field, 3-3 from the arc and 2-2 from the free throw line for 19 points. Last season, senior forward Pablo Rivas matched a rare feat of former Eagle Dominique Sutton against Western Carolina on Nov. 16, as he went 7-for-7 from the floor and 2-for-2 from the free throw line for 18 points and nine rebounds. McKnight and Rivas are in rare company now, joining Emmanuel Chapman as the only other Eagles to shoot 100 percent from the floor with a spotless three-point percentage as well. Rivas shot 100 percent from the floor a second time at Missouri, but missed one free throw for 16 points and six rebounds (6-6 FG, 4-5 FT).

#### SLIPPERY ROCK

The Eagles were bitten by the turnover bug as they lost the rock 26 times at Evansville, the most since Jan. 15, 2010 during the Division I transition when the Eagles turned the ball over 27 times against Tennessee Temple.

#### ABOUT THE 2016-17 SEASON

-Patrick Cole became the third Eagle to be named conference Player of the Year by putting up 19.6 points, 6.9 rebounds and 5.7 assists per game.

-NCCU went 11-2 at McDougald-McLendon Arena, securing its eighth consecutive winning season at home.

- The Eagles captured their third MEAC Regular Season title and made their second NCAA Tournament appearance after going 13-3 in league play.

-NCCU once again was one of the best defensive teams in the league, allowing just 63.5 points per game to lead the league, and was 11th in the nation in field goal percentage allowed at 39.3 percent.

#### THE NEW NEST

McDougald-McLendon Arena received some renovations during the offseason before the 2015-16 season, and now boasts the most biomechanically-sophisticated maple sports floor system in the state of North Carolina. The facility also received high-efficiency LED lights from Cree, Inc. as part of a UNC system-wide project, and has a center-hung Daktronics videoboard. ### NATION'S SECOND-LONGEST HOME WIN STREAK

NCCU held a 38-game home win streak, which ranked second in Division I behind Arizona. The Eagles had not lost at home since Dec. 4, 2012 (Eastern Kentucky, 57-63). The last MEAC team to beat NCCU in Durham was Savannah State on Feb. 11, 2012 (67-57) before Howard ended the streak on Dec. 7, 2015 (71-69). NCCU defeated 26 consecutive conference opponents during the run.

### WE MUST PROTECT THE NEST

During the 2013-14 season, North Carolina Central University went unbeaten at home going 14-0, marking that feat for the first time since the 1997-98 campaign. The Eagles have now gone undefeated at home in consecutive seasons for the first time in school history.

#### Eagles Close November with Big Win

DURHAM, N.C. – North Carolina Central University scored the third-most points in school history in a 116-38 win over Christendom College to close the first month of completion on Thursday, Nov. 30 inside McDougald-McLendon Arena.

The margin of victory of 78 points is the most for NCCU (4-5) since an 85-point win over Saint Augustine's on Feb. 18, 1944 (119-36). The most points the Eagles have scored was 123 against College of Faith on Nov. 18, 2014.

Christendom (0-4) won the opening tip and scored first in the contest, but the Eagles were able to quickly grab the advantage and led for all but one minute and 12 seconds of the contest.

For the second consecutive game, and fourth time this season, NCCU shot over 50 percent from the floor, making 52.9 percent of its attempts. Every eligible Eagle checked in to the game, and 12 players recorded at least one point, while seven scored in double-digits.

Dominique Reid (Sicklerville, N.J.) put up game-highs and collected his first double-double with 15 points and 16 rebounds for the Eagles, and was 7-for-9 from the floor. Raasean Davis (Chicago, Ill.) was also 7-for-9 for 14 points, and Larry McKnight, Jr. (North Miami, Fla.) collected 14 points as well.

John Guerra (Cary, N.C.) set new career-highs with 11 points, three assists and a game-high four steals in 12 minutes off the bench for NCCU. Three Eagles finished with 10 points, with Zacarry Douglas (Landover, Md.) and Jordan Perkins (Greensboro, N.C.) landing there with Pablo Rivas (Colón, Panama) who also had seven boards.

C.J. Wiggins (Richmond, Va.) was again the leading assist man for the Eagles with seven helpers alongside nine points, and Alston Jones (Kansas City, Mo.) was right behind him with six assists and seven points. Marius McAllister (Durham, N.C.) also reached a new career mark with eight boards, the second-most on the team along with six points and three assists in 18 minutes of action.

### Eagles Fall in Precision Shootout with SEMO

URHAM, N.C. – North Carolina Central University went on a 10-0 run to bridge the first and second halves to tie the game early in the second period, but Southeast Missouri State was able to reclaim the lead and an 86-77 decision at McDougald-McLendon Arena on Saturday, Dec. 2.

For the fifth time this year, NCCU (4-6) shot over 50 percent from the floor (50.9 percent), but SEMO (4-4) shot 56.4 percent, including 64.3 percent in the second half, helped by shooting 85.7 percent (6-7) from the arc after the break.

SEMO jumped out on a 5-0 run to open the game, and the Redhawks wouldn't let NCCU get ahead of them for the entire contest. The Redhawks kept trying to pull away from the Eagles in the first 20 minutes, but NCCU was able to stay close.

SEMO went out by as many as 10 with 1:43 left in the first half, but NCCU rattled off seven unanswered points from there, capped by a tip-in by Brandon Goldsmith (Raleigh, N.C.) right before time expired with the Eagles trailing 38-35.

Raasean Davis (Chicago, Ill.) manufactured a three-point play to open the second half to tie the contest at 38, but SEMO responded with a 10-0 run to create separation that it would keep for the rest of the game.

Reggie Gardner, Jr. (Bowie, Md.) had a career day with a game-high 26 points, and Pablo Rivas (Colón, Panama) notched his third double-double of the year with 19 points and 12 boards. Davis finished with 11 points, and Jordan Perkins (Greensboro, N.C.) dished out a game-high and career-high 10 assists.

Justin Carpenter (Mt. Carmel, Ill.) led five double-digit scorers for SEMO with 20 points and six rebounds on a perfect 8-for-8 from the field, including a three pointer and a 3-for-3 mark from the free throw line. He was followed by Denzel Mahoney (Oviedo, Fla.) with 19 points and five caroms. Both Daniel Simmons (Biggersville, Miss.) and Milos Vranes (Belgrade, Serbia) had 10 points and four boards, and Ledarrius Brewer (Meridian, Miss.) had 12 points with four rebounds.

On March 25, 2009, arguably one of the greatest players in school history was elevated from Assistant Coach to the position of Head Coach, becoming the 17th to be named in that spot in the program's history

During the 2016-17 season Moton led the Eagles to a 25-9 overall record and a 13-3 MEAC mark, and he joined rare company with John B. McLendon as the only coaches with four 20-win seasons at NCCU. NCCU captured its third MEAC regular-season championship and second MEAC Tournament championship within a four year span to make its second Division-I NCAA Tournament appearance. The Eagles also made history with their first win over an SEC opponent with a wire-to-wire 62-52 win at Missouri. NCCU went on a 13-game win streak during conference play, the second-longest win streak in the Division I era. The Eagles continued to pride itself on defense by being second in the nation in three-point defense, allowing just 29.0 percent of made attempts. NCCU was also top-10 in field goal percentage defense (39.1), top-25 in scoring defense (63.4 points per game) and top-15 in scoring margin (11.7 points per game).

Close to 25 years after the magical run of the 1989 NCAA Division II National Championship team, and just 10 days shy of the fifth anniversary of the day of his official hiring, NCCU soared to its first MEAC Tournament Championship on March 15, 2014 following its 71-62 victory over Morgan State in front of a near-capacity crowd inside the Norfolk Scope Arena. The 2013-14 Eagles tied a school record in wins (28), won the most games in a season for any squad in MEAC history, and was the lowest seed for any league champion in the NCAA Tournament as the maroon and gray earned a 14seed in the East Region. Moton's squad finished 15-1 in conference play earning the school's first Division I regular season title and won 20 straight contests, which set a new NCAA Division I level record for the program.

The following year, his sixth season as head coach at NCCU, Moton guided the 2014-15 Eagles to a 25-8 overall record, including a 19-3 mark during the final three-and-a-half months, as well as the school's first appearance in the National Invitation Tournament. The 2014-15 squad made history by becoming the first men's basketball team in school history to post an unbeaten regularseason conference record at 16-0 to repeat as MEAC regular-season champions. The Eagles were among the top five defenses in Division I, ranking second in field goal percentage defense (behind Kentucky), fourth in three-point field goal percentage defense and fifth in scoring defense. NCCU completed the campaign by extending the second-longest home win streak in Division I at 35 victories in-a-row (behind Arizona).

Moton joined hall of fame coach John McLendon and national championship coach Michael Bernard as the only coaches in NCCU men's basketball history to lead the Eagles to three straight 20-win seasons. As a credit to the program's recent success, NCCU boasts the best regular-season conference record during the last three seasons at 46-2, a winning percentage of .958.

With the rings of a champion came the accolades as Moton earned MEAC Coach of the Year honors, MEAC Tournament's Most Outstanding Coach award, and was named the BoxtoRow.com HBCU National Coach of the Year, while earning finalist spots in the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year Award (Top-Mid-Major Coach), and the Top Minority Coach honor, the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Award.

The maroon and gray's second season in the MEAC, Moton's fourth, was the coming out party for the program. For the first time at the NCAA Division I level, the Eagles won 20 games finishing the year 22-9, and went 15-1 in conference play to earn the No. 2 seed in the conference tournament. Moton earned national praise by being named a finalist for the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Award, and the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year of Award, along with Co-Coach of the Year in the MEAC by CollegeInsider.com.

In his third season in charge of NCCU, Moton took his team to a place not since seen since the 2004-05 season when the Eagles finished with a winning record (17-15) and were seeded fifth in their first MEAC Tournament at the Division I level.

His second year at the helm his squad showed the Eagle Nation how bright the future was as his squad racked up 15 wins and recorded the first non-losing season in nearly six years. He earned NCAA Division I Independent Coach of the Year honors.

He initially returned to his alma mater as assistant men's basketball coach in July 2007.

The Hall-of-Famer joined the NCCU staff after serving as head boys basketball coach at Sanderson High School in his hometown of Raleigh, N.C. During his three-year tenure (2004-07) at Sanderson, Moton led the Spartans to an overall record of 59-25, while winning back-to-back Cap-7 tournament championships in 2006 and 2007.

A 1996 graduate of NCCU with a bachelor's degree in recreation administration, Moton became

the school's third all-time leading scorer with 1,714 points during his historic hardwood career as an Eagle from 1992-96, earning the nickname "Poetry `n Moton."

During his junior and senior seasons, Moton was voted All-CIAA First Team, NCAA Division II South Atlantic All-Region First Team and NCAA Division II All-America Honorable Mention. He was named the 1996 CIAA (Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association) Men's Basketball Player of the Year and was inducted into the NCCU Athletic Hall of Fame in 2004.

Among NCCU's all-time career leaders, Moton ranks first in 3-point field goals made (213 of 529), third in scoring (1,714 points), fourth in free throws made (363 of 467), fifth in assists (278), eighth in field goals made (569 of 1,159), 10th in scoring average (16.6 points per game), and 11th in steals (110).

As a junior (1994-95), he topped the CIAA and was No. 16 in NCAA Division II in scoring with an average of 23.5 points per game. His 87 made three-point field goals that year remains the school's single-season record.

As a senior (1995-96), he placed second in the CIAA with 21.3 points per game and ranked among the conference's top 10 statistical leaders in assists, free throw percentage and 3-point

Moton played on three CIAA Southern Division Championship teams and made two trips to the NCAA playoffs, including an NCAA Division II South Atlantic Regional Championship title in 1993.

After NCCU, Moton played four years of professional basketball in Indonesia (1996-97) and Israel (1998-99). Throughout his professional playing career, Moton averaged 25.0 points per contest, and dished out a little more than five assists per game as a pro.

He was head coach at West Millbrook Middle School for three seasons (2001-04) before taking over the Sanderson boys basketball program in 2004.

Moton is a 1992 graduate of Enloe High School in Raleigh, N.C., where he was named Cap5 Player of the Year as a senior.

In December of 2013, Moton received his Master's degree in Special Education with a focus on Learning Disabilities.

He and his wife, Bridget, married on June 28, 2008. They have two children Brooke and
