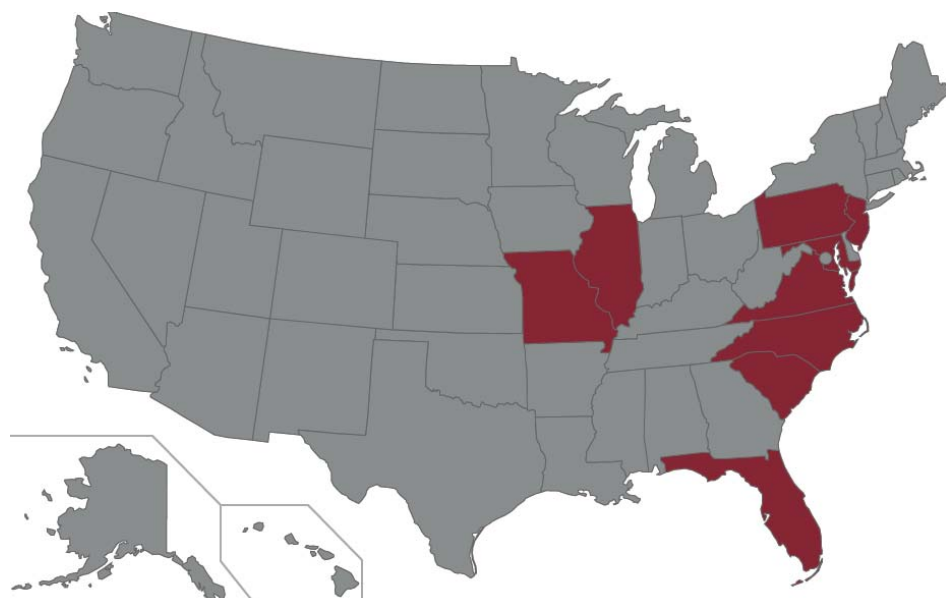

STARTING FIVE:

1. Head coach LeVelle Moton is one win away from passing Gregory Jackson for the third-most wins all time at NCCU.
2. NCCU has now won 1200 games in the 84th season of the program history.
3. With nine home wins already this season, NCCU has clinched its ninth consecutive home winning campaign.
4. Coach Moton is 92-32 all-time in regular season MEAC play.
5. NCCU is looking for its fourth regular season MEAC title in the last five seasons.

SCOUTING THE HAWKS:

Maryland Eastern Shore comes to Durham with a 2-10 mark in MEAC play, and has dropped its last two games. MDES and NCCU met earlier this year in Princess Anne, where the Eagles won 63-60. Logan McIntosh put in a game-high 26 points for the Hawks in that contest, and he leads his squad in scoring with 12.2 points per contest along with 4.0 rebounds and 4.6 assists.

FREE BASKETBALL

NCCU played an overtime game for the first time since the 2015-16 season when the Eagles fell 84-78 at Howard. Under Moton, the Eagles are 7-4 in games that go to an extra frame, and 3-3 against MEAC opponents in overtime.

NEXT MAN UP

NCCU is one of less than 10 schools that returns zero starters from its previous season. The Eagles bring back the second-fewest starts in the nation with 11, all coming from C.J. Wiggins, and the third-fewest total minutes with 862, 626 of which came from Pablo Rivas.

CRASHING THE BOARDS

NCCU pulled down the most rebounds in the Division-I era against Warren Wilson when the Eagles swept up 66 rebounds. The Eagles topped the mark of 57 set against Barber-Scotia on Dec. 17, 2014. This season, the Eagles also pulled down 58 boards against Christendom on Dec. 30.

COMING UP ACES

NCCU currently leads the MEAC in four categories after a strong showing during the non-conference schedule. The Eagles are tops in the league in points allowed per game (69.5), field goal percentage (47.4), rebounding margin (+5.0), and rebounds allowed per game (32.4).

ROOKIE RANKING

Freshmen Reggie Gardner, Jr. and Jordan Perkins have found their way into the starting lineup, and are the first freshmen to start for the Eagles since C.J. Wiggins during the 2015-16 season. Gardner and Perkins are both statistically ranked within the MEAC, as well. Gardner is top-25 in scoring with an average of 11.4 points per game and is a volume shooter from the perimeter, ranking sixth in threes per game with 2.3. Perkins has taken on his role as a point guard and is fourth in the league in assists with 4.9 per outing and is fourth in assist-to-turnover ratio with a positive 1.8.

Larry McKnight, Jr. was highly efficient from the floor at Marshall as he was 7-for-7 from the field, 3-3 from the arc and 2-2 from the free throw line for 19 points. Last season, senior forward Pablo Rivas matched a rare feat of former Eagle Dominique Sutton against Western Carolina on Nov. 16, as he went 7-for-7 from the floor and 2-for-2 from the free throw line for 18 points and nine rebounds. McKnight and Rivas are in rare company now, joining Emmanuel Chapman as the only other Eagles to shoot 100 percent from the floor with a spotless three-point percentage as well. Rivas shot 100 percent from the floor a second time at Missouri, but missed one free throw for 16 points and six rebounds (6-6 FG, 4-5 FT).

SLIPPERY ROCK

The Eagles were bitten by the turnover bug as they lost the rock 26 times at Evansville, the most since Jan. 15, 2010 during the Division I transition when the Eagles turned the ball over 27 times against Tennessee Temple.

-Patrick Cole became the third Eagle to be named conference Player of the Year by putting up 19.6 points, 6.9 rebounds and 5.7 assists per game.

-NCCU went 11-2 at McDougald-McLendon Arena, securing its eighth consecutive winning season at home.

- The Eagles captured their third MEAC Regular Season title and made their second NCAA Tournament appearance after going 13-3 in league play.

-NCCU once again was one of the best defensive teams in the league, allowing just 63.5 points per game to lead the league, and was 11th in the nation in field goal percentage allowed at 39.3 percent.

GOOD YEAR

NATION'S SECOND-LONGEST HOME WIN STREAK

NCCU held a 38-game home win streak, which ranked second in Division I behind Arizona. The Eagles had not lost at home since Dec. 4, 2012 (Eastern Kentucky, 57-63). The last MEAC team to beat NCCU in Durham was Savannah State on Feb. 11, 2012 (67-57) before Howard ended the streak on Dec. 7, 2015 (71-69). NCCU defeated 26 consecutive conference opponents during the run.

WE MUST PROTECT THE NEST

During the 2013-14 season, North Carolina Central University went unbeaten at home going 14-0, marking that feat for the first time since the 1997-98 campaign. The Eagles have now gone undefeated at home in consecutive seasons for the first time in school history.

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. – North Carolina Central University and Florida A&M went back and forth in the second half, but the Rattlers were able to hold off the Eagles for a 65-56 final score at the Lawson Center on Saturday, Feb. 10.

FAMU (5-22, 4-7 MEAC) controlled the early stages of the contest, and led NCCU (12-12, 6-4 MEAC) by as many as 12 in the first half. The Eagles hung tight, and were able to close the gap with help from a first half double-double from Raasean Davis (Chicago, Ill.) who collected 10 points and 10 rebounds in the first 20 minutes as the Eagles went to the half trailing 28-25.

Pablo Rivas (Colon, Panama) came alive in the second half as he fired in critical three pointers along with his teammate Zacarry Douglas (Lando-ver, Md.) to help the Eagles grab their lead of the contest in what would become a seesaw affair as the lead would change hands multiple times in the middle stages of the second half.

The Rattlers were eventually able to pull away and hold onto the lead on the way to a 65-56 final score, with a lot of help coming from Desmond Williams (Almore, Ala.) who scored 16 of his game-high 21 points in the second half.

Davis finished with 14 points and 12 rebounds for his sixth double-double of the year, and Rivas was just shy of the mark with 12 points and nine boards. Raekwon Harney (Winston-Salem, N.C.) played extended minutes and dished out a game-high five assists with seven points.

Williams collected a team-high eight rebounds for the Rattlers, and Marcus Barham (Melbourne, Fla.) collected 20 points with five boards. Elijah Mayes (Orlando, Fla.) put in 13 for FAMU as the third player with 10+ points for the hosts.

The Eagles as a team comfortably outrebounded FAMU 47-31, and with that margin, NCCU outscored the Rattlers 27-8 in second-chance points.

Eagles Outraced by Bethune-Cookman

DAYTONA BEACH, Fla. – North Carolina Central University ran into a red-hot Bethune-Cookman team on Monday, Feb. 10 as the Eagles fell 99-81 inside Moore Gym.

BCU (14-12, 8-3 MEAC) was off to a blistering pace early in the contest and started the game shooting 7-for-10 from the perimeter to lead NCCU (12-13, 6-5 MEAC) by as many as 24 on the way to a 55-31 score at the midway point.

Jeffrey Altdort (Coral Springs, Fla.) was the catalyst for the Wildcats in the first 20 minutes as he knocked down his first three treys, and turned in 15 points at the intermission. Raasean Davis (Chicago, Ill.) did his part for the Eagles as well as he was 5-for-5 from the floor with a team-high 11 points and four rebounds at the half.

NCCU outscored BCU 50-44 in the second half, but was unable to surmount the first-half deficit on the way to a 99-81 final score.

The Eagles collected three double-doubles, headlined by Jordan Perkins (Greensboro, N.C.) who tied career highs and got his first career double-double with 17 points and 10 assists. Davis reached a career-high as well with 26 points and 11 rebounds, and was 8-for-8 from the floor before finishing 12-for-15. Pablo Rivas (Colón, Panama) was the third Eagle with a double-double with 21 points and 10 boards with three blocks.

BCU was led by Brandon Tabb (Hampton, Va.) who registered a game-high 25 points and four steals, and Isaiah Bailey (Compton, Calif.) had a complete game with 22 points, eight assists and five rebounds. Shawntrez Davis (Atlanta, Ga.) was strong inside with 18 points, seven rebounds and four blocks for the Wildcats, and Soufiane Diakite (Bronx, N.Y.) was the fourth BCU player in double-digits with 16 points and seven caroms.

There were a total of 96 points scored in the paint, with the Eagles getting the lion's share, 50-46.

the school's third all-time leading scorer with 1,714 points during his historic hardwood career as an Eagle from 1992-96, earning the nickname "Poetry 'n Moton."

During his junior and senior seasons, Moton was voted All-CIAA First Team, NCAA Division II South Atlantic All-Region First Team and NCAA Division II All-America Honorable Mention. He was named the 1996 CIAA [Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association] Men's Basketball Player of the Year and was inducted into the NCCU Athletic Hall of Fame in 2004.

Among NCCU's all-time career leaders, Moton ranks first in 3-point field goals made (213 of 529), third in scoring (1,714 points), fourth in free throws made (363 of 467), fifth in assists (278), eighth in field goals made (569 of 1,159), 10th in scoring average (16.6 points per game), and 11th in steals (110).

As a junior (1994-95), he topped the CIAA and was No. 16 in NCAA Division II in scoring with an average of 23.5 points per game. His 87 made three-point field goals that year remains the school's single-season record.

As a senior (1995-96), he placed second in the CIAA with 21.3 points per game and ranked among the conference's top 10 statistical leaders in assists, free throw percentage and 3-point field goal percentage.

Moton played on three CIAA Southern Division Championship teams and made two trips to the NCAA playoffs, including an NCAA Division II South Atlantic Regional Championship title in 1993.

After NCCU, Moton played four years of professional basketball in Indonesia (1996-97) and Israel (1998-99). Throughout his professional playing career, Moton averaged 25.0 points per contest, and dished out a little more than five assists per game as a pro.

He was head coach at West Millbrook Middle School for three seasons (2001-04) before taking over the Sanderson boys basketball program in 2004.

Moton is a 1992 graduate of Enloe High School in Raleigh, N.C., where he was named Cap5 Player of the Year as a senior.

In December of 2013, Moton received his Master's degree in Special Education with a focus on Learning Disabilities.

He and his wife, Bridget, married on June 28, 2008. They have two children Brooke and LeVelle Jr.

On March 25, 2009, arguably one of the greatest players in school history was elevated from Assistant Coach to the position of Head Coach, becoming the 17th to be named in that spot in the program's history.

During the 2016-17 season Moton led the Eagles to a 25-9 overall record and a 13-3 MEAC mark, and he joined rare company with John B. McLendon as the only coaches with four 20-win seasons at NCCU. NCCU captured its third MEAC regular-season championship and second MEAC Tournament championship within a four year span to make its second Division-I NCAA Tournament appearance. The Eagles also made history with their first win over an SEC opponent with a wire-to-wire 62-52 win at Missouri. NCCU went on a 13-game win streak during conference play, the second-longest win streak in the Division I era. The Eagles continued to pride itself on defense by being second in the nation in three-point defense, allowing just 29.0 percent of made attempts. NCCU was also top-10 in field goal percentage defense (39.1), top-25 in scoring defense (63.4 points per game) and top-15 in scoring margin (11.7 points per game).

Close to 25 years after the magical run of the 1989 NCAA Division II National Championship team, and just 10 days shy of the fifth anniversary of the day of his official hiring, NCCU soared to its first MEAC Tournament Championship on March 15, 2014 following its 71-62 victory over Morgan State in front of a near-capacity crowd inside the Norfolk Scope Arena. The 2013-14 Eagles tied a school record in wins (28), won the most games in a season for any squad in MEAC history, and was the lowest seed for any league champion in the NCAA Tournament as the maroon and gray earned a 14-seed in the East Region. Moton's squad finished 15-1 in conference play earning the school's first Division I regular season title and won 20 straight contests, which set a new NCAA Division I level record for the program.

The following year, his sixth season as head coach at NCCU, Moton guided the 2014-15 Eagles to a 25-8 overall record, including a 19-3 mark during the final three-and-a-half months, as well as the school's first appearance in the National Invitation Tournament. The 2014-15 squad made history by becoming the first men's basketball team in school history to post an unbeaten regular-season conference record at 16-0 to repeat as MEAC regular-season champions. The Eagles were among the top five defenses in Division I, ranking second in field goal percentage defense (behind Kentucky), fourth in three-point field goal percentage defense and fifth in scoring defense. NCCU completed the campaign by extending the second-longest home win streak in Division I at 35 victories in-a-row (behind Arizona).

Moton joined hall of fame coach John McLendon and national championship coach Michael Bernard as the only coaches in NCCU men's basketball history to lead the Eagles to three straight 20-win seasons. As a credit to the program's recent success, NCCU boasts the best regular-season conference record during the last three seasons at 46-2, a winning percentage of .958.

With the rings of a champion came the accolades as Moton earned MEAC Coach of the Year honors, MEAC Tournament's Most Outstanding Coach award, and was named the BoxtoRow.com HBCU National Coach of the Year, while earning finalist spots in the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year Award (Top-Mid-Major Coach), and the Top Minority Coach honor, the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Award.

The maroon and gray's second season in the MEAC, Moton's fourth, was the coming out party for the program. For the first time at the NCAA Division I level, the Eagles won 20 games finishing the year 22-9, and went 15-1 in conference play to earn the No. 2 seed in the conference tournament. Moton earned national praise by being named a finalist for the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Award, and the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year Award, along with Co-Coach of the Year in the MEAC by CollegeInsider.com.

In his third season in charge of NCCU, Moton took his team to a place not since seen since the 2004-05 season when the Eagles finished with a winning record (17-15) and were seeded fifth in their first MEAC Tournament at the Division I level.

His second year at the helm his squad showed the Eagle Nation how bright the future was as his squad racked up 15 wins and recorded the first non-losing season in nearly six years. He earned NCAA Division I Independent Coach of the Year honors.

He initially returned to his alma mater as assistant men's basketball coach in July 2007.

The Hall-of-Famer joined the NCCU staff after serving as head boys basketball coach at Sanderson High School in his hometown of Raleigh, N.C. During his three-year tenure (2004-07) at Sanderson, Moton led the Spartans to an overall record of 59-25, while winning back-to-back Cap-7 tournament championships in 2006 and 2007.

A 1996 graduate of NCCU with a bachelor's degree in recreation administration, Moton became
