

SCOUTING THE PIRATES:

This matchup marks an end of an era as NCCU meets Hampton for the final time as per game. Hampton had a trio of 20-point scorers against North Carolina A&T in a 92-84 loss, led by Marrow's 24, followed by Akim Mitchell with 21, and Lysander Bracey with 20.

FREE BASKETBALL

NCCU played an overtime game for the first time since the 2015-16 season when the Eagles fell 84-78 at Howard. Under Moton, the Eagles are 7-4 in games that go to an extra frame, and 3-3 against MEAC opponents in overtime.

NEXT MAN UP

NCCU is one of less than 10 schools that returns zero starters from its previous season. The Eagles bring back the second-fewest starts in the nation with 11, all coming from C.J. Wiggins, and the third-fewest total minutes with 862, 626 of which came from Pablo Rivas.

CRASHING THE BOARDS

NCCU pulled down the most rebounds in the Division-I era against Warren Wilson when the Eagles swept up 66 rebounds. The Eagles topped the mark of 57 set against Barber-Scotia on Dec. 17, 2014. This season, the Eagles also pulled down 58 boards against Christendom'on Dec. 30.

ROOKIE RANKING
Freshmen Reggie Gardner, Jr. and Jordan
Perkins have found their way into the starting lineup, and are the first freshmen to start
for the Eagles since C.J. Wiggins during the
2015-16 season. Gardner and Perkins are
both statistically rapked within the MFAC. NCCU meets Hampton for the final time as MEAC foes, and the Eagles will finish with a winning record in the MEAC series. The Pirates are 4-4 in league play, led by Jeramaine Marrow's 20 points and 5.8 assists woll. Gardner is top-20 in scoring with an average of 11.9 points per game and is a volume shooter from the perimeter, ranking sixth in threes per game with 2.5. Perkins has taken on his role as a point guard and is third in the league in assists with 4.9 per outing and is fourth in assist-to-turnover ratio with a positive 1.9.

Larry McKnight, Jr. was highly efficient from the floor at Marshall as he was 7-for-7 from the field, 3-3 from the arc and 2-2 from the free throw line for 19 points. Last season, senior forward Pablo Rivas matched a rare feat of former Eagle Dominique Sutton against Western Carolina on Nov. 16, as he went 7-for-7 from the floor and 2-for-2 from the free throw line for 18 points and nine rebounds. McKnight and Rivas are in rare rebounds. McKnight and kivas are in rate company now, joining Emmanuel Chapman as the only other Eagles to shoot 100 percent from the floor with a spotless three-point percentage as well. Rivas shot 100 percent from the floor a second time at Missouri, but missed one free throw for 16 points and six rebounds (6-6 FG, 4-5 FT).

ABOUT THE 2016-17 SEASON

-Patrick Cole became the third Eagle to be named conference Player of the Year by putting up 19.6 points, 6.9 rebounds and 5.7 assists per game.

-NCCU went 11-2 at McDougald-McLendon Arena, securing its eighth consecutive winning season at home.

- The Eagles captured their third MEAC Regular Season title and made their second NCAA Tournament appearance after going 13-3 in league play.

-NCCU once again was one of the best defensive teams in the league, allowing just 63.5 points per game to lead the league, and was 11th in the nation in field goal percentage allowed at 39.3 percent.

NATION'S SECOND-LONGEST HOME WIN **STREAK**

NCCU held a 38-game home win streak, which ranked second in Division I behind Arizona. The Eagles had not lost at home since Dec. 4, 2012 (Eastern Kentucky, 57-63). The last MEAC team to beat NCCU in Durham was Savannah State on Feb. 11, 2012 (67-57) before Howard ended the streak on Dec. 7, 2015 (71-69). NCCU defeated 26 consecutive conference opponents during the run.

WE MUST PROTECT THE NEST

Eagles Falter at North Carolina A&T

GREENSBORO, N.C. – North Carolina Central University saw a second-half lead slip away as North Carolina A&T rallied to defeat the Eagles, 70-64 at the Corbett Center on Saturday, Jan. 27.

NCCU (11-10, 5-2 MEAC) and NC A&T (13-9, 6-1 MEAC) played almost identical first halves statistically, and went to the break even at 28 points apiece after a fall away jumper at the buzzer from Raekwon Harney (Winston-Salem, N.C.).

Pablo Rivas (Colón, Panama) powered the Eagles ahead in the first half with 11 points and five rebounds as both the Eagles and Aggies made 11 field goals, two three pointers and four free throws in the first 20 minutes.

NCCU kicked it into high gear to start the second half, as the maroon and gray went on a 20-3 run over the first six-and-a-half minutes to open up a 48-31 advantage. From that point on, the Aggies chipped away at the deficit and eventually pulled ahead with four minutes to go, motored by 15 second-half points from Denzel Keyes (Kinston, N.C.) on the way to a game-high 20.

Jordan Perkins (Greensboro, N.C.) hit a clutch three-pointer on the move late in the game to try to help the Eagles make a comeback, but the Aggies were able to withstand the late push for a 70-64 final.

Raasean Davis (Chicago, Ill.) had a team-high 15 points with six rebounds, and both Rivas and Reggie Gardner, Jr. (Bowie, Md.) contributed 13 points, with Rivas adding a team-high eight rebounds. Perkins was friendly with the basketball, serving up a game-high seven assists with nine points and four rebounds as well. Larry McKnight, Jr. (North Miami, Fla.) swiped a career-high four steals as well with eight points.

Kameron Langley (Greensboro, N.C.) had 13 points for the Aggies, and Devonte Boykins (Forest City, N.C.) also finished in double-digits with 11 points. Femi Olujobi (Long Island, N.Y.) had a game-high nine rebounds with seven points.

Eagles Shrug off Slow Start to Beat Delaware State

DURHAM, N.C. – North Carolina Central University found itself down double-digits in the first half against Delaware State before going on a 27-8 run that led to a 72-61 win on Saturday, Feb. 3 at McDougald-McLendon Arena.

DSU (2-22, 0-9 MEAC) started the game extremely hot from the floor, making 10 of 12 shots to open up a 17-point advantage over NCCU (12-10, 6-2 MEAC). The Eagles were able to find their footing shortly after that, going on a big run highlighted by four steals to flip the script and take a 40-37 lead to the locker room at the half.

After the break, the Eagles were able to charge ahead with a 17-point lead of their own on the way to a 72-61 final score. NCCU held DSU to just 29.6 percent shooting in the second half, and allowed just two made three-pointers in 10 attempts. The Eagles, on the other hand, shot an even 50 percent from the floor after the intermission.

Senior guard Raekwon Harney (Winston-Salem, N.C.) had a career night for the maroon and gray with a game-high 10 assists and five steals, and Raasean Davis (Chicago, Ill.) pulled down his sixth double-double of the year as he tied his career-high with 23 points and added 10 boards. Pablo Rivas (Colón, Panama) came off the bench with 12 points and six rebounds with a pair of blocks, and Jordan Perkins (Greensboro, N.C.) filled the stat book with 10 points, seven rebounds, six assists and two steals. Reggie Gardner, Jr. (Bowie, Md.) was a sharpshooter for the Eagles with three made treys for 13 points.

Jonathan Walker (Lithia Springs, Ga.) led the Hornets in scoring with 19 points, and Artem Tavakalyan (Moscow, Russia) was right behind him with 17 points. Marquis Collins (Chester, Pa.) was the third double figure scorer for DSU with 15 points.

On March 25, 2009, arguably one of the greatest players in school history was elevated from Assistant Coach to the position of Head Coach, becoming the 17th to be named in that spot in the program's history

During the 2016-17 season Moton led the Eagles to a 25-9 overall record and a 13-3 MEAC mark, and he joined rare company with John B. McLendon as the only coaches with four 20-win seasons at NCCU. NCCU captured its third MEAC regular-season championship and second MEAC Tournament championship within a four year span to make its second Division-I NCAA Tournament appearance. The Eagles also made history with their first win over an SEC opponent with a wire-to-wire 62-52 win at Missouri. NCCU went on a 13-game win streak during conference play, the second-longest win streak in the Division I era. The Eagles continued to pride itself on defense by being second in the nation in three-point defense, allowing just 29.0 percent of made attempts. NCCU was also top-10 in field goal percentage defense (39.1), top-25 in scoring defense (63.4 points per game) and top-15 in scoring margin (11.7 points per game).

Close to 25 years after the magical run of the 1989 NCAA Division II National Championship team, and just 10 days shy of the fifth anniversary of the day of his official hiring, NCCU soared to its first MEAC Tournament Championship on March 15, 2014 following its 71-62 victory over Morgan State in front of a near-capacity crowd inside the Norfolk Scope Arena. The 2013-14 Eagles tied a school record in wins [28], won the most games in a season for any squad in MEAC history, and was the lowest seed for any league champion in the NCAA Tournament as the maroon and gray earned a 14seed in the East Region. Moton's squad finished 15-1 in conference play earning the school's first Division I regular season title and won 20 straight contests, which set a new NCAA Division I level record for the program.

The following year, his sixth season as head coach at NCCU, Moton guided the 2014-15 Eagles to a 25-8 overall record, including a 19-3 mark during the final three-and-a-half months, as well as the school's first appearance in the National Invitation Tournament. The 2014-15 squad made history by becoming the first men's basketball team in school history to post an unbeaten regularseason conference record at 16-0 to repeat as MEAC regular-season champions. The Eagles were among the top five defenses in Division I, ranking second in field goal percentage defense (behind Kentucky), fourth in three-point field goal percentage defense and fifth in scoring defense. NCCU completed the campaign by extending the second-longest home win streak in Division I at 35 victories in-a-row (behind Arizona).

Moton joined hall of fame coach John McLendon and national championship coach Michael Bernard as the only coaches in NCCU men's basketball history to lead the Eagles to three straight 20-win seasons. As a credit to the program's recent success, NCCU boasts the best regular-season conference record during the last three seasons at 46-2, a winning percentage of .958.

With the rings of a champion came the accolades as Moton earned MEAC Coach of the Year honors, MEAC Tournament's Most Outstanding Coach award, and was named the BoxtoRow.com HBCU National Coach of the Year, while earning finalist spots in the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year Award (Top-Mid-Major Coach), and the Top Minority Coach honor, the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Award.

The maroon and gray's second season in the MEAC, Moton's fourth, was the coming out party for the program. For the first time at the NCAA Division I level, the Eagles won 20 games finishing the year 22-9, and went 15-1 in conference play to earn the No. 2 seed in the conference tournament. Moton earned national praise by being named a finalist for the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Award, and the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year of Award, along with Co-Coach of the Year in the MEAC by CollegeInsider.com.

In his third season in charge of NCCU, Moton took his team to a place not since seen since the 2004-05 season when the Eagles finished with a winning record (17-15) and were seeded fifth in their first MEAC Tournament at the Division I level.

His second year at the helm his squad showed the Eagle Nation how bright the future was as his squad racked up 15 wins and recorded the first non-losing season in nearly six years. He earned NCAA Division I Independent Coach of the Year honors.

He initially returned to his alma mater as assistant men's basketball coach in July 2007.

The Hall-of-Famer joined the NCCU staff after serving as head boys basketball coach at Sanderson High School in his hometown of Raleigh, N.C. During his three-year tenure (2004-07) at Sanderson, Moton led the Spartans to an overall record of 59-25, while winning back-to-back Cap-7 tournament championships in 2006 and 2007.

A 1996 graduate of NCCU with a bachelor's degree in recreation administration, Moton became

the school's third all-time leading scorer with 1,714 points during his historic hardwood career as an Eagle from 1992-96, earning the nickname "Poetry `n Moton."

During his junior and senior seasons, Moton was voted All-CIAA First Team, NCAA Division II South Atlantic All-Region First Team and NCAA Division II All-America Honorable Mention. He was named the 1996 CIAA (Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association) Men's Basketball Player of the Year and was inducted into the NCCU Athletic Hall of Fame in 2004.

Among NCCU's all-time career leaders, Moton ranks first in 3-point field goals made (213 of 529), third in scoring (1,714 points), fourth in free throws made (363 of 467), fifth in assists (278), eighth in field goals made (569 of 1,159), 10th in scoring average (16.6 points per game), and 11th in steals (110).

As a junior (1994-95), he topped the CIAA and was No. 16 in NCAA Division II in scoring with an average of 23.5 points per game. His 87 made three-point field goals that year remains the school's single-season record.

As a senior (1995-96), he placed second in the CIAA with 21.3 points per game and ranked among the conference's top 10 statistical leaders in assists, free throw percentage and 3-point

Moton played on three CIAA Southern Division Championship teams and made two trips to the NCAA playoffs, including an NCAA Division II South Atlantic Regional Championship title in 1993.

After NCCU, Moton played four years of professional basketball in Indonesia (1996-97) and Israel (1998-99). Throughout his professional playing career, Moton averaged 25.0 points per contest, and dished out a little more than five assists per game as a pro.

He was head coach at West Millbrook Middle School for three seasons (2001-04) before taking over the Sanderson boys basketball program in 2004.

Moton is a 1992 graduate of Enloe High School in Raleigh, N.C., where he was named Cap5 Player of the Year as a senior.

In December of 2013, Moton received his Master's degree in Special Education with a focus on Learning Disabilities.

He and his wife, Bridget, married on June 28, 2008. They have two children Brooke and




