PREVIEW: @NCCUWBB Visits Wofford, Hosts No. 18 Oregon State

DURHAM, N.C. – The North Carolina Central University women's basketball team will play back-to-back games before Thanksgiving as the Eagles travel to Wofford College for an 11 a.m. contest on Tuesday before hosting 18th-ranked Oregon State University on Wednesday at 2 p.m.

N.C. Central Women's Basketball

The Eagles, who were picked to finished last in the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) in the league's preseason poll, opened up the Trisha Stafford-Odom era with a statement 87-75 home victory over Longwood University last week. NCCU (1-1 Overall) then suffered its first loss of the season in its road opener at Wofford University, 77-56, on Tuesday.

A pair of guards have started off their junior year in impressive fashion. Jayla Calhoun is the reigning MEAC Player of the Week after scoring a career-high 25 points against the Lancers. She is averaging 16.5 points per game. Rodneysha Martin has reached double-digit scoring in both contests and leads the Eagles with 17.0 points per game. Martin, who notched NCCU's first double-double in two seasons against Longwood, also paces the squad with 8.0 rebounds per game.

Junior transfer Caira Benton is averaging nine points per game to lead another group of five Eagles averaging between 5-8 points per contest.

Junior guard Dominique Adams is NCCU's top returning scorer at 6.6 points per game. Sophomore Jada Blow, who averaged nearly two 3-pointers per contest as a rookie, has made a couple treys in both outings to start her second season. Afriyie led the Eagles with 5.5 rebounds per game last year while junior Deja McCain followed closely behind with 5.3 boards per outing.

The maroon and gray are averaging 22.5 turnovers and 26.0 fouls per game, both numbers worth watching against Oregon State. However, 77.3-percent marksmanship from the free throw line along with 9.0 assists and 4.5 blocks per game are all positive trending numbers.

NCCU will be playing Oregon State for the first time and it will mark the program's first game against a nationally-ranked opponent since dropping a 90-26 decision at #1/2 South Carolina on Dec. 1, 2014.

Oregon State Women's Basketball

The Beavers are ranked 18th in both national polls (AP and USA Today/WBCA Coaches) and are coming off their first loss on Sunday against No. 5 Notre Dame, 72-67. Oregon State (2-1 Overall) has won 30-plus games each of the last two seasons with a Sweet 16 appearance last year and a Final Four run in 2016.

Sophomore guard Mikayla Piviec was a Pac-12 All-Freshman honoree and is showing no signs of a sophomore slump as she leads the Beavers with 17.3 points, 9.7 rebounds and 7.0 assists per game. Senior center Marie Gulich, who earned Pac-12 First Team attention last season, is also averaging nearly a double-double with 15.0 points and 9.3 rebounds per contests while adding 4.7 blocks per game.

Freshman guard Aleah Goodman (12.0 ppg), sophomore guard Kat Tudor (10.7) and junior guard Taylor Kalmer (10.3) all average 10 points per game for a deep backcourt.

OSU has traveled the nearly 2,400 miles from Corvallis, Oregon, to spend its Thanksgiving break in Durham. The Beavers will play No. 16 Duke on Saturday.

OVERALL (4th Season) Record: 38-46 (.452) Trisha Stafford-Odom was announced as North Carolina Central University's ninth head women's basketball coach in May of 2017. She has a reputation as one of the nation's top recruiters and has over 10 years of coaching experience, including stints at UNC and Duke.

The former Women's National Basketball Association (WNBA) player and collegiate hall of fame inductee returns to The Triangle to continue her head coaching career after last coaching three seasons at Concordia University Irvine from 2013-2016. Prior to that, Stafford-Odom was a successful assistant coach for four seasons with both the UNC Tar Heels and Duke Blue Devils. She began her collegiate coaching career as an assistant for the UCLA Bruins.

Stafford-Odom won the Concordia Eagles first conference championship in 18 years to highlight her time coaching in California. In her second season as head coach, CUI posted a 23-7 record and won the Golden State Athletic Conference (GSAC) Championship. She produced two All-Americans and was named the league's coach of the year.

As an assistant coach at UNC from 2011-2013, Stafford-Odom was a valuable recruiter for the No. 1 nationally-ranked recruiting class in 2013. She aided the development of two WNBA players, two ACC Players of the Year and two ACC Freshmen of the Year while working under the leadership of Naismith Hall of Fame coach Sylvia Hatchell.

Stafford-Odom brought her first No. 1 nationally-ranked recruiting class to Durham when she was an assistant at Duke from 2009-2011. The Blue Devils won the ACC Championship both seasons as she mentored WNBA draft picks, an ACC Tournament MVP, a two-time ACC Academic All-American and a ACC Defensive Player of the Year.

While at UCLA from 2005-2008, Stafford-Odom was the recruiting coordinator for a No. 3 nationally-ranked recruiting class her first season and went on to develop two top-5 WNBA draft picks and the Pac-10 Tournament MVP.

Stafford-Odom was enshrined into the Cal Athletic Hall of Fame in 2013. She led the Golden Bears to their first two NCAA Tournament appearances. She was a multiple All-Pac-10 honoree as well as a Kodak All-America honorable mention. Stafford-Odom averaged 15.3 points during her four seasons (sixth all-time at Cal) and led the Pac-10 in scoring with over 23 points her senior year.

After graduating from the University of California, Berkeley with a degree in mass communications in 1992, Stafford-Odom pursued a professional basketball playing career that included a couple years in the WNBA with Houston (2001) and Miami (2002) as well as time in the ABL, NWBL, NBDL, NBA Entertainment League and European leagues.

Stafford-Odom continued her education while coaching at Concordia Irvine and earned a Master of Arts degree in coaching and athletic administration in 2015, and continues to be a student in the assistant coaches program of the NBA.

Trisha is married to DeWayne and the couple has two sons, Amari and Trajen.

NCCU ASSISTANT COACH TYNESHA LEWIS



Tynesha Lewis joined the NCCU women's basketball coaching staff in June of 2017 as an assistant coach.

"Nothing makes me more comfortable than knowing the very knowledgeable and uber-efficient Tynesha Lewis is ready to be in the trenches with me on the sidelines," said Stafford-Odom. "Her accomplishments as a player and her energetic approach to entrepreneurship and personal growth was revealed to me over the course of our long term-friendship. I am

grateful Coach Ty was willing to reinsert herself into the women's game."

Lewis, who played six seasons in the Women's National Basketball Association (WNBA), returns to The Triangle after playing collegiately at North Carolina State University in Raleigh. She will be working primarily with NCCU's point guards and on shooting the ball.

After being drafted as the 21st overall pick in the 2001 WNBA draft, Lewis played six professional seasons split between the Houston Comets, Charlotte Sting and Minnesota Lynx.

Since retiring in 2007, she has spent most of her time as an educator, motivational speaker and in sales.

Lewis has collegiate coaching experience as an assistant coach with Illinois State University.

The Macclesfield, North Carolina, product had an outstanding collegiate career for the Wolfpack. Lewis was a four-time All-Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) honoree under coaching legend Kay Yow. She scored 1,621 points for NCSU and finished with career averages of 13.2 points, 5.3 rebounds, 2.8 assists and 1.3 steals. She played on a Final Four team in 1998 and a Sweet 16 squad in 2001.

Lewis graduated from North Carolina State with a Bachelor of Arts degree in chemistry in 2001 before earning a Bachelor of Science degree in biological science in 2014. She continued her education with master's degrees from American InterContinental University (business administration - marketing) and Grand Canyon University (education/curriculum - integration of technology).

NCCU ASSISTANT COACH A.G. HALL

Hall, who was an assistant for the Lady Eagles when they advanced to the NCAA Division II Tournament on back-to-back seasons at the start of the millennium, returns to the NCCU coaching staff after having gained head coaching experience in July of 2017.

He spent four years as head coach at Winston-Salem State University from 2012-16, which included a pair of 15-win seasons. The Rams 2012-13 squad under Hall was ranked No. 2 in NCAA Division II in team defense, allowing just 51 points per game.



"Adding the wisdom and experience of A.G. is something I am very proud of," said Stafford-Odom. "I have seen him operate with professionalism throughout his coaching years. He has a calming demeanor and a motor that motivates players to push harder. For me to find an individual who walked the path of a collegiate athlete here at NCCU and who has posted winning seasons as a college head coach, I am thrilled. I know the influx of knowledge A.G. will share will help move our program forward."

Hall has a total of 16 years of collegiate women's basketball coaching experience, which features 10 years as an assistant at the Division I level between Providence College (2002-08), Clemson University (2008-10) and Bethune-Cookman University (2010-12).

After graduating NCCU with a Bachelor of Business Administration (B.B.A.) with a major in accounting in 1998, Hall started his coaching career at his alma mater for two seasons from 2000-02. The Lady Eagles went 49-13 over that span, winning consecutive Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association (CIAA) Western Division titles before advancing to the NCAA Tournament both seasons. The 2001-02 team in Hall's second season won its first two tourney games before being eliminated in the round of 16.

Hall played 58 games for the Eagles and was a teammate with current NCCU head men's basketball coach LeVelle Moton.

NCCU DIRECTOR OF OPERATION CLARISSA ADAMS



Adams will serve as the director of basketball operations at NCCU beginning in 2017-18 after spending the past decade with the women's basketball program at the University of North Carolina.

While in Chapel Hill, Adams served as the director of student-athlete development/recruiting assistant under the leadership of Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame inducted coaching legend Sylvia Hatchell since 2007. Her tenure at UNC included two seasons with Stafford-Odom, who was an assistant coach for the Tar Heels from 2011-2013.

"There was an instantaneous aura of professionalism when I met Clarissa years ago," said Stafford-Odom. "Her uncanny ability to promote positive alternatives and to bring resolve to situations that appear unresolvable render her invaluable. Clarrisa will be

an essential resource to our student-athletes as they navigate their way through college and prepare for life after athletics. She will bring life to the community and media presence of women's basketball, and she will effectively communicate the daily and long term direction of our program."

Adams, who worked with the UNC football and men's basketball teams as an undergraduate, earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in exercise and sports science from UNC in 2005. She started her career in collegiate athletics by working in both the UNC football operations and recruiting departments before moving over to women's basketball program two years later.

Adams is a National Academy of Sports Medicine (NASM) certified personal trainer.
