PREVIEW: @NCCUWBB Hosts Coppin State Saturday

DURHAM, N.C. – The North Carolina Central University women's basketball team will try and move over .500 in the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) when the Eagles host a couple of matinees against Coppin State University on Saturday and Morgan State University on Monday. Both contests are scheduled to tip-off at 2 p.m.

N.C. Central Women's Basketball

The Eagles were handed their first conference loss in a 75-60 home setback to the league's hottest team in Norfolk State University on Monday. NCCU (3-12 Overall, 1-1 MEAC) is 2-3 at home.

Freshman guard Kieche White is the reigning MEAC Rookie of the Week and sophomore forward Paulina Afriyie was tabbed MEAC Co-Defensive Player of the Week. White scored a career-high 20 points in NCCU's league-opening win at Delaware State and then she led the Eagles with 12 points against the Spartans. White is averaging 6.9 points per game, including 4.0 made 3-pointers per game in conference play. Afriyie ranks amongst the league's statistical leaders with 7.3 rebounds per game, 1.1 blocks per game and a field-goal percentage of 46.5%. Afriyie, who has four double-doubles on the season, is second on the team in scoring (8.3 ppg) has pulled down double-digit rebounds in five of the last six games.

Junior guard Rodneysha Martin continues to lead the maroon and gray with 12.7 points and 2.3 assists per game. She also ranks as the league's third best free-throw shooter at 82.1%.

A pair of junior transfers in Sami Oliver-Alexander and Caira Benton supplement NCCU's scoring with averages of 7.0 and 5.4 points per game, respectively, while classmate Jayla Calhoun is contributing 5.9 points and 4.3 rebounds per game.

NCCU knocked off Coppin State, 58-46, last season with junior Dominique Adams scoring a career-high 17 points in that triumph.

Coppin State Women's Basketball

After losing their MEAC opener at Norfolk State (71-57), the Eagles have won their last two league contests at home to Savannah State University (66-57) and Florida A&M University (62-56). Coppin State (3-12 Overall, 2-1 MEAC) is still searching for its first road win (0-11).

The CSU Eagles are led by a pair of preseason All-MEAC selections in senior guard Genesis Lucas and sophomore center Chance Graham. Lucas is the reigning MEAC Player of the Week and she leads the conference with 19.0 points per game, 4.3 assists per game and an 84% free throw percentage. She also ranks third in the league with 2.6 steals per game and 2.1 made 3-pointers per game. Graham shared MEAC Co-Defensive Player of the Week laurels with Afriyie and she is the league's top rebounder at 9.3 rebounds per game. Graham also contributes 11.2 points per game.

Freshman guard Maraiyah Smith (8.3 ppg) and senior forward Candice Beverly (7.6 ppg) add scoring depth for Coppin State.

Lucas led the CSU Eagles with 12 points in last year's 12-point loss to NCCU while Graham grabbed a gamehigh nine rebounds.

The former Women's National Basketball Association (WNBA) player and collegiate hall of fame inductee returns to The Triangle to continue her head coaching career after last coaching three seasons at Concordia University Irvine from 2013-2016. Prior to that, Stafford-Odom was a successful assistant coach for four seasons with both the UNC Tar Heels and Duke Blue Devils. She began her collegiate coaching career as an assistant for the UCLA Bruins.

Stafford-Odom won the Concordia Eagles first conference championship in 18 years to highlight her time coaching in California. In her second season as head coach, CUI posted a 23-7 record and won the Golden State Athletic Conference (GSAC) Championship. She produced two All-Americans and was named the league's coach of the year.

As an assistant coach at UNC from 2011-2013, Stafford-Odom was a valuable recruiter for the No. 1 nationally-ranked recruiting class in 2013. She aided the development of two WNBA players, two ACC Players of the Year and two ACC Freshmen of the Year while working under the leadership of Naismith Hall of Fame coach Sylvia Hatchell.

Stafford-Odom brought her first No. 1 nationally-ranked recruiting class to Durham when she was an assistant at Duke from 2009-2011. The Blue Devils won the ACC Championship both seasons as she mentored WNBA draft picks, an ACC Tournament MVP, a two-time ACC Academic All-American and a ACC Defensive Player of the Year.

While at UCLA from 2005-2008, Stafford-Odom was the recruiting coordinator for a No. 3 nationally-ranked recruiting class her first season and went on to develop two top-5 WNBA draft picks and the Pac-10 Tournament MVP.

Stafford-Odom was enshrined into the Cal Athletic Hall of Fame in 2013. She led the Golden Bears to their first two NCAA Tournament appearances. She was a multiple All-Pac-10 honoree as well as a Kodak All-America honorable mention. Stafford-Odom averaged 15.3 points during her four seasons (sixth all-time at Cal) and led the Pac-10 in scoring with over 23 points her senior year.

After graduating from the University of California, Berkeley with a degree in mass communications in 1992, Stafford-Odom pursued a professional basketball playing career that included a couple years in the WNBA with Houston (2001) and Miami (2002) as well as time in the ABL, NWBL, NBDL, NBA Entertainment League and European leagues.

Stafford-Odom continued her education while coaching at Concordia Irvine and earned a Master of Arts degree in coaching and athletic administration in 2015, and continues to be a student in the assistant coaches program of the NBA.

Trisha is married to DeWayne and the couple has two sons, Amari and Trajen.

NCCU ASSISTANT COACH TYNESHA LEWIS



Tynesha Lewis joined the NCCU women's basketball coaching staff in June of 2017 as an assistant coach.

"Nothing makes me more comfortable than knowing the very knowledgeable and uber-efficient Tynesha Lewis is ready to be in the trenches with me on the sidelines," said Stafford-Odom. "Her accomplishments as a player and her energetic approach to entrepreneurship and personal growth was revealed to me over the course of our long term-friendship. I am

grateful Coach Ty was willing to reinsert herself into the women's game."

Lewis, who played six seasons in the Women's National Basketball Association (WNBA), returns to The Triangle after playing collegiately at North Carolina State University in Raleigh. She will be working primarily with NCCU's point guards and on shooting the ball.

After being drafted as the 21st overall pick in the 2001 WNBA draft, Lewis played six professional seasons split between the Houston Comets, Charlotte Sting and Minnesota Lynx.

Since retiring in 2007, she has spent most of her time as an educator, motivational speaker and in sales.

Lewis has collegiate coaching experience as an assistant coach with Illinois State University.

The Macclesfield, North Carolina, product had an outstanding collegiate career for the Wolfpack. Lewis was a four-time All-Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) honoree under coaching legend Kay Yow. She scored 1,621 points for NCSU and finished with career averages of 13.2 points, 5.3 rebounds, 2.8 assists and 1.3 steals. She played on a Final Four team in 1998 and a Sweet 16 squad in 2001.

Lewis graduated from North Carolina State with a Bachelor of Arts degree in chemistry in 2001 before earning a Bachelor of Science degree in biological science in 2014. She continued her education with master's degrees from American InterContinental University (business administration - marketing) and Grand Canyon University (education/curriculum - integration of technology).

NCCU ASSISTANT COACH A.G. HALL

Hall, who was an assistant for the Lady Eagles when they advanced to the NCAA Division II Tournament on backto-back seasons at the start of the millennium, returns to the NCCU coaching staff after having gained head coaching experience in July of 2017.

He spent four years as head coach at Winston-Salem State University from 2012-16, which included a pair of 15-win seasons. The Rams 2012-13 squad under Hall was ranked No. 2 in NCAA Division II in team defense, allowing just 51 points per game.



"Adding the wisdom and experience of A.G. is something I am very proud of," said Stafford-Odom. "I have seen him operate with professionalism throughout his coaching years. He has a calming demeanor and a motor that motivates players to push harder. For me to find an individual who walked the path of a collegiate athlete here at NCCU and who has posted winning seasons as a college head coach, I am thrilled. I know the influx of knowledge A.G. will share will help move our program forward."

Hall has a total of 16 years of collegiate women's basketball coaching experience, which features 10 years as an assistant at the Division I level between Providence College (2002-08), Clemson University (2008-10) and Bethune-Cookman University (2010-12).

After graduating NCCU with a Bachelor of Business Administration (B.B.A.) with a major in accounting in 1998, Hall started his coaching career at his alma mater for two seasons from 2000-02. The Lady Eagles went 49-13 over that span, winning consecutive Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association (CIAA) Western Division titles before advancing to the NCAA Tournament both seasons. The 2001-02 team in Hall's second season won its first two tourney games before being eliminated in the round of 16.

Hall played 58 games for the Eagles and was a teammate with current NCCU head men's basketball coach LeVelle Moton.

NCCU DIRECTOR OF OPERATION CLARISSA ADAMS



Adams will serve as the director of basketball operations at NCCU beginning in 2017-18 after spending the past decade with the women's basketball program at the University of North Carolina.

While in Chapel Hill, Adams served as the director of student-athlete development/recruiting assistant under the leadership of Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame inducted coaching legend Sylvia Hatchell since 2007. Her tenure at UNC included two seasons with Stafford-Odom, who was an assistant coach for the Tar Heels from 2011-2013.

"There was an instantaneous aura of professionalism when I met Clarissa years ago," said Stafford-Odom. "Her uncanny ability to promote positive alternatives and to bring resolve to situations that appear unresolvable render her invaluable. Clarrisa will be

an essential resource to our student-athletes as they navigate their way through college and prepare for life after athletics. She will bring life to the community and media presence of women's basketball, and she will effectively communicate the daily and long term direction of our program."

Adams, who worked with the UNC football and men's basketball teams as an undergraduate, earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in exercise and sports science from UNC in 2005. She started her career in collegiate athletics by working in both the UNC football operations and recruiting departments before moving over to women's basketball program two years later.

Adams is a National Academy of Sports Medicine (NASM) certified personal trainer.
