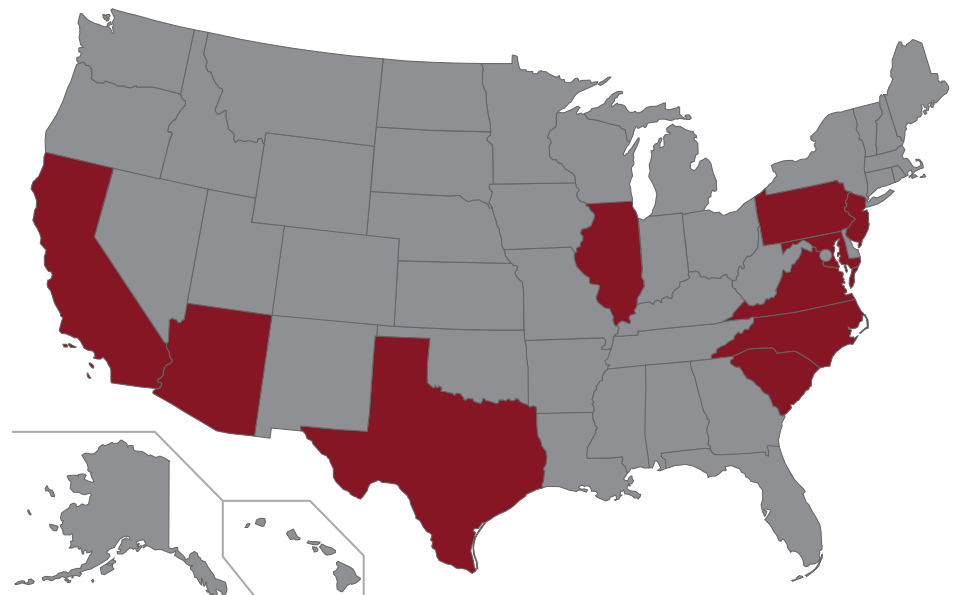

SCOUTING THE AGGIES

UC Davis makes its first NCAA Tournament appearance after emerging as the Big West Tournament champion. The Aggies finished second in the Big West with a conference record of 11-5 and overall record of 21-12. UC Davis was an impressive 11-0 at home, and a combined 10-12 away from home. The Aggies bring two All-Big West First Team players in Brynton Lemar and Chima Moneke, with Moneke also being named Newcomer of the Year in the league. Through the league tournament, Lemar leads the squad in scoring with 16.0 points per game and also has 2.7 assists per outing, and Moneke is the leading rebounder with 9.5 caroms per game along with 14.5 points per contest. Brynton led the way in the Aggies' 50-47 championship win over Cal State Fullerton with a game-high 20 points.

HELLO AGAIN!

NCCU is making its second NCAA Tournament appearance, and its third postseason appearance in the Division-I era as the Eagles begin their journey in the First Four in Dayton, Ohio. NCCU's last NCAA tournament appearance was in 2014, when the Eagles fell to #3 Iowa State, 93-75. The Eagles' last postseason appearance was an NIT trip to Miami (Fl.) where the Eagles were defeated 75-71.

CHAMPIONSHIP LOCKDOWN

NCCU helped to secure its MEAC Championship over Norfolk State by going on a remarkable 19-0 run in the second half, holding the Spartans without a single point for over 11 minutes of play. The Eagles forced 14 missed shots and caused five turnovers from the 14:33 mark to 3:20 remaining in regulation.

THE ENVELOPE, PLEASE

NCCU earned three individual awards for the 2016-17 season as Patrick Cole was named MEAC Player of the Year as well as First Team All-MEAC, and head coach LeVelle Moton earned his second MEAC Coach of the Year award. Dajuan Graf was

also voted Second Team All-MEAC. Cole is just the third Eagle to be named conference Player of the Year following Moton (CIAA Player of the Year, 1995-96) and Jeremy Ingram (MEAC Player of the Year, 2013-14). He finished the regular season as the leading assist maker in the league with 5.8 per game, and that is good for 22nd in the nation in NCAA Division-I. He also finished third in scoring with 19.8 points per game, and fifth in rebounding with 6.9 per outing. Moton coached the Eagles to a 23-7 record, and are ranked as one of the top-10 most improved in NCAA Division-I, and the Eagles also carried a 13-game win streak during the year. Graf finished the regular season as the second leading assist man in the MEAC with 5.2 per game, and was top-15 in scoring with 14.1 points per game. He was also one of the most efficient shooters, making 47.8 percent of his shots, good for top-10 in the league.

DEFESNE! DEFENSE!

NCCU prides itself on defense, and for good reason as the Eagles are one of the best defensive teams in the nation. NCCU is second in NCAA Division-I in three-point defense, allowing just 29.0 percent of made three-point attempts, and are 10th in field-goal percentage defense and 39.1 percent. The Eagles are also 22nd in scoring defense by allowing just 63.4 points per game, and that helped them to the 14th best scoring margin of 11.7 points per contest.

NEWCOMERS NO MORE

In just six seasons as a Division I program - NCCU achieved full NCAA Division I membership in August 2011 - the Eagles have posted four 20-win campaigns, earned three MEAC regular-season championships (2013-14, 2014-15, 2016-17) and won two MEAC tournament championships (2014, 2017). Two seasons ago, NCCU participated in the NIT with a road game against the University of Miami.

NICE TO MEET YOU

NCCU played Northern Kentucky, Missouri, Ohio State, LSU, McNeese State and Truett-McConnell for the first time during the 2016-17 season, and the Eagles emerged with a 4-2 record against those schools with the only losses coming against OSU and LSU. This is NCCU's first meeting with UC Davis.

FLYING HIGH IN THE MEAC

NCCU sits in the top-four of every MEAC stat category except for one, and within the individual stat categories over 20 spots are taken up by Eagles. As a team, the Eagles are first in six separate categories. (Page 6)

HELPER, HELPER

Senior guards Patrick Cole and Dajuan Graf have been scoring the ball well this season, but they have also gotten their teammates involved as the top two assisters in the MEAC. Cole is first with 5.7 per game, followed by Graf at 5.2.

FROM DOWNTOWN!

Dajuan Graf and Ron Trapps were on target at Coppin State as the two guards combined to go 9-for-9 from the perimeter in an 86-77 win on Feb. 6. Trapps was 5-for-5 for 18 points, and Graf was 4-4 for 25 points.

WINDOW WASHERS

NCCU pulled down an incredible 56 rebounds against Montreat, with 26 offensive boards and 30 defensive caroms. That stacks up as the second-most rebounds in a game in the Division-I era for the Eagles, behind 57 against Barber-Scotia on Dec. 17, 2014.

BLOCK PARTY

The Eagles protected the paint on the road at Missouri as NCCU recorded eight blocks, tied for the seventh-most in a game in the Division-I era. Will Ransom swatted four by himself, which is tied for the third-most in a game in the same time frame.

HOW CAN I ASSIST YOU?

Senior guard Patrick Cole dished out a career-high 13 assists against LIU Brooklyn, tied for the fifth-most in a single game alongside Nimrod Hilliard (at ETSU, Jan. 31, 2015) and all-time assists leader Emanuel Chapman (vs. Coppin State Jan. 26, 2013). Cole is currently ranked in the Top-25 in assists the NCAA Division-I with 5.8 assists per game as of Feb. 17.

GOING BACK-TO-BACK

Patrick Cole became the first two-time and back-to-back recipient of the MEAC Player of the Week honor from both the conference and College Sports Madness in the 2016-17 season on Monday, Nov. 28 after a strong four-game stretch from Nov. 14 to Nov. 26 with 23.0 points, 8.0 rebounds and 6.8 assists per game. Cole again earned back-to-back MEAC Player of the Week honors on Feb. 13 after averaging 24.8 points, 6.0 rebounds and 5.5 assists over four games from Jan. 30 to Feb. 11, and he has been named MEAC Player of the Week in consecutive weeks three times now. Kyle Benton also has been named MEAC Defensive Player of the Week in back-to-back weeks as he averaged 9.8 boards per game with eight blocks and five steals from Feb. 13-25.

TRIPLE, DOUBLE

Patrick Cole made history when he recorded the first triple-double in the Division-I era for NCCU with 14 points, 12 rebounds and 10 assists against Jackson State. Dajuan Graf picked up a double-double in the same game with 15 points and 11 assists, making both players the first with double-digit assists since the 2014-15 season.

100%

Junior forward Pablo Rivas matched a rare feat of former Eagle Dominique Sutton against Western Carolina on Nov. 16, as he went 7-for-7 from the floor and 2-for-2 from the free throw line for 18 points and nine rebounds. He also put himself into a more exclusive group by joining Emmanuel Chapman as the only other Eagle to shoot 100 percent from the floor with a spotless three-point percentage as well. Rivas shot 100 percent from the floor a second time at Missouri, but missed one free throw for 16 points and six rebounds (6-6 FG, 4-5 FT).

-NCCU went 8-5 at McDougald-McLendon Arena, securing its seventh consecutive winning season at home.

- Led by returner Rashaun Madison, NCCU topped the MEAC in three-point percentage with 34.8 percent of attempts made.

-NCCU once again was one of the best defensive teams in the league, allowing just 69.8 points per game, good for second in the conference.

THE NEW NEST

McDougald-McLendon Arena received some renovations during the offseason before the 2015-16 season, and now boasts the most biomechanically-sophisticated maple sports floor system in the state of North Carolina. The facility also received high-efficiency LED lights from Cree, Inc. as part of a UNC system-wide project, and has a center-hung Daktronics videoboard. NATION'S SECOND-LONGEST HOME WIN STREAK

NCCU held a 38-game home win streak, which ranked second in Division I behind Arizona. The Eagles had not lost at home since Dec. 4, 2012 (Eastern Kentucky, 57-63). The last MEAC team to beat NCCU in Durham was Savannah State on Feb. 11, 2012 (67-57) before Howard ended the streak on Dec. 7, 2015 (71-69). NCCU defeated 26 consecutive conference opponents during the run.

WE MUST PROTECT THE NEST

During the 2013-14 season, North Carolina Central University went unbeaten at home going 14-0, marking that feat for the first time since the 1997-98 campaign. The Eagles have now gone undefeated at home in consecutive seasons for the first time in school history.

Eagles Fly past Hawks to Final

NORFOLK, Va. – North Carolina Central University endured a 30-plus minute delay due to a shot clock malfunction in the first half, but that couldn't stop the Eagles' momentum as they advanced past Maryland Eastern Shore into the championship, 77-49 on Friday, March 10 at Scope Arena.

NCCU (24-8) opened the game on a 10-0 run and that set the tone for the Eagles for the rest of the game. NCCU led MDES (15-16) 14-2 when the shot clock above the goal where the Eagles were attacking went out at the 13:27 minute mark in the first half, and both sides had to wait over a half hour for a solution.

Eventually the timer came back on, and the Eagles went on to take a commanding 38-21 lead at the break after a big three-pointer from Patrick Cole (Newark, N.J.) with less than 10 seconds remaining in the half.

The Eagles opened the second half on a 21-4 run to lead 60-25 with 12:33 to play, and saw out the victory from there. Cole finished with a game-high 21 points with seven rebounds and six assists, and he was one of five Eagles with a double-digit point total.

Dajuan Graf (Charlotte, N.C.) had 14 points with four assists, and Kyle Benton (Long Beach, Calif.) had 12 points and a joint game-high eight rebounds shared with Del'vin Dickerson (Houston, Texas). Dickerson collected 11 points, followed by Pablo Rivas (Phoenix, Ariz.) who finished with 10 points and six boards.

Bakari Copeland (Decatur, Ga.) led MDES with 15 points.

NCCU Eagles Punch Ticket to NCAA Tournament

NORFOLK, Va. – North Carolina Central University had to battle Norfolk State for every point in the first half, but a 19-0 run in the second half proved to be the difference as the Eagles won the 2017 MEAC Tournament Championship for the second time in the Division-I era, 67-59 on Saturday, March 11 at Scope Arena.

NCCU (25-8) has now won both of its championship appearances in the Division-I era, and will make its second NCAA Tournament appearance, following the Eagles' inaugural trip in 2014.

The first 20 minutes was a back-and-forth affair with both teams trading buckets, and neither leading by more than six points. NCCU had a clean look at the bucket at the end of the first half, but a three-pointer came up just a bit short and the Eagles went to the half trailing NSU (17-16) 38-35.

The second half began by following the same trend, but at the 13:49 mark the Eagles took the lead 47-46 and didn't look back. NCCU held the Spartans scoreless for 11 consecutive minutes, and forced 14 missed shots and five turnovers.

Patrick Cole (Newark, N.J.) posted a joint game-high 18 points with eight rebounds and three assists, followed by Dajuan Graf (Charlotte, N.C.) with 17 points and four assists. Rashaun Madison (Norfolk, Va.) was the third Eagle in double-digits with 12 points and three made trey. Kyle Benton (Long Beach, Calif.) was close to a double-double with eight points and eight boards, as was Del'vin Dickerson (Houston, Texas) with seven points and seven rebounds.

Zaynah Robinson (Atlanta, Ga.) led the Spartans with 18 points and six rebounds with four assists, and Kerwin Okoro (Bronx, N.Y.) was another top performer with 12 points.

Cole was named the Most Outstanding Player of the tournament, and head coach LeVelle Moton was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Coach. Graf rounded out the individual honors by joining Cole on the All-Tournament Team.

South Atlantic All-Region First Team and NCAA Division II All-America Honorable Mention. He was named the 1996 CIAA (Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association) Men's Basketball Player of the Year and was inducted into the NCCU Athletic Hall of Fame in 2004.

Among NCCU's all-time career leaders, Moton ranks first in 3-point field goals made (213 of 529), third in scoring (1,714 points), fourth in free throws made (363 of 467), fifth in assists (278), eighth in field goals made (569 of 1,159), 10th in scoring average (16.6 points per game), and 11th in steals (110).

As a junior (1994-95), he topped the CIAA and was No. 16 in NCAA Division II in scoring with an average of 23.5 points per game. His 87 made three-point field goals that year remains the school's single-season record.

As a senior (1995-96), he placed second in the CIAA with 21.3 points per game and ranked among the conference's top 10 statistical leaders in assists, free throw percentage and 3-point field goal percentage.

Moton played on three CIAA Southern Division Championship teams and made two trips to the NCAA playoffs, including an NCAA Division II South Atlantic Regional Championship title in 1993.

After NCCU, Moton played four years of professional basketball in Indonesia (1996-97) and Israel (1998-99). Throughout his professional playing career, Moton averaged 25.0 points per contest, and dished out a little more than five assists per game as a pro.

He was head coach at West Millbrook Middle School for three seasons (2001-04) before taking over the Sanderson boys basketball program in 2004.

Moton is a 1992 graduate of Enloe High School in Raleigh, N.C., where he was named Cap5 Player of the Year as a senior.

In December of 2013, Moton received his Master's degree in Special Education with a focus on Learning Disabilities.

He and his wife, Bridget, married on June 28, 2008. They have two children Brooke and LeVelle Jr.

On March 25, 2009, arguably one of the greatest players in school history was elevated from Assistant Coach to the position of Head Coach, becoming the 17th to be named in that spot in the program's history.

Close to 25 years after the magical run of the 1989 NCAA Division II National Championship team, and just 10 days shy of the fifth anniversary of the day of his official hiring, NCCU soared to its first MEAC Tournament Championship on March 15, 2014 following its 71-62 victory over Morgan State in front of a near-capacity crowd inside the Norfolk Scope Arena. The 2013-14 Eagles tied a school record in wins (28), won the most games in a season for any squad in MEAC history, and was the lowest seed for any league champion in the NCAA Tournament as the maroon and gray earned a 14-seed in the East Region. Moton's squad finished 15-1 in conference play earning the school's first Division I regular season title and won 20 straight contests, which set a new NCAA Division I level record for the program.

The following year, his sixth season as head coach at NCCU, Moton guided the 2014-15 Eagles to a 25-8 overall record, including a 19-3 mark during the final three-and-a-half months, as well as the school's first appearance in the National Invitation Tournament. The 2014-15 squad made history by becoming the first men's basketball team in school history to post an unbeaten regular-season conference record at 16-0 to repeat as MEAC regular-season champions. The Eagles were among the top five defenses in Division I, ranking second in field goal percentage defense (behind Kentucky), fourth in three-point field goal percentage defense and fifth in scoring defense. NCCU completed the campaign by extending the second-longest home win streak in Division I at 35 victories in-a-row (behind Arizona).

Moton joined hall of fame coach John McLendon and national championship coach Michael Bernard as the only coaches in NCCU men's basketball history to lead the Eagles to three straight 20-win seasons. As a credit to the program's recent success, NCCU boasts the best regular-season conference record during the last three seasons at 46-2, a winning percentage of .958.

With the rings of a champion came the accolades as Moton earned MEAC Coach of the Year honors, MEAC Tournament's Most Outstanding Coach award, and was named the BoxtoRow.com HBCU National Coach of the Year, while earning finalist spots in the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year Award (Top-Mid-Major Coach), and the Top Minority Coach honor, the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Award.

The maroon and gray's second season in the MEAC, Moton's fourth, was the coming out party for the program. For the first time at the NCAA Division I level, the Eagles won 20 games finishing the year 22-9, and went 15-1 in conference play to earn the No. 2 seed in the conference tournament. Moton earned national praise by being named a finalist for the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Award, and the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year Award, along with Co-Coach of the Year in the MEAC by CollegeInsider.com.

In his third season in charge of NCCU, Moton took his team to a place not since seen since the 2004-05 season when the Eagles finished with a winning record (17-15) and were seeded fifth in their first MEAC Tournament at the Division I level.

His second year at the helm his squad showed the Eagle Nation how bright the future was as his squad racked up 15 wins and recorded the first non-losing season in nearly six years. He earned NCAA Division I Independent Coach of the Year honors.

He initially returned to his alma mater as assistant men's basketball coach in July 2007.

The Hall-of-Famer joined the NCCU staff after serving as head boys basketball coach at Sanderson High School in his hometown of Raleigh, N.C. During his three-year tenure (2004-07) at Sanderson, Moton led the Spartans to an overall record of 59-25, while winning back-to-back Cap-7 tournament championships in 2006 and 2007.

A 1996 graduate of NCCU with a bachelor's degree in recreation administration, Moton became the school's third all-time leading scorer with 1,714 points during his historic hardwood career as an Eagle from 1992-96, earning the nickname "Poetry 'n Moton."

During his junior and senior seasons, Moton was voted All-CIAA First Team, NCAA Division II

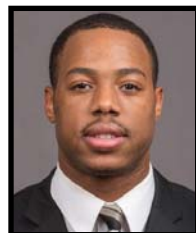
