

STARTING FIVE:

1. Head coach LeVelle Moton has now won 171 games at NCCU, and has passed Gregory Jackson for the third-most wins all time at NCCU.
2. NCCU has now won over 1200 games in the 84th season of the program history.
3. The Eagles have one NCAA Division-II National Championship, defeating Southeast Missouri State 73-45 in 1989.
4. Coach Moton is 95-34 all-time in regular season MEAC play.
5. NCCU is 12-4 in the MEAC Tournament under Moton with three titles.

SCOUTING THE TIGERS

Texas Southern makes its fourth NCAA Tournament appearance in the last five years as the champion of the Southwestern Athletic Conference, this year defeating top-seeded Arkansas-Pine Bluff 84-69. The Tigers enter the NCAA Tournament with a 15-19 overall record, and went 12-6 in league play within the SWAC. TSU is led by the electric Demontre Jefferson who averages 23.4 points and 4.5 assists per game, and also shoots 39.4 percent from the perimeter. Donte Clark also plays a big role with 18.6 points and 5.3 rebounds per game. In the championship game against UAPB, Jefferson contributed 15 points with six rebounds and seven assists, followed by Clark with 14 points and six assists. Derrick Bruce also stepped in with 13 points and six assists.

THREE IN FIVE

NCCU makes its third NCAA Tournament appearance within the last five years, and the Eagles are still on the hunt for their first win. NCCU's first trip was as a No. 14 seed against Iowa State, and the Eagles were defeated 93-75 during the 2014 tournament. Last year, the Eagles also went to Dayton for the First Four and were felled by UC Davis, 67-63.

BACK-TO-BACK CHAMPS

For the first time in the Division-I era, NCCU has captured back-to-back MEAC Tournament championships, and will head to the NCAA Tournament in consecutive years. This is also the first time the Eagles have won the tournament without being the No. 1 seed, winning the tournament as the No. 6 seed for the first time since Hampton in 2015. The Eagles are also the first back-to-back MEAC Tournament champion since Hampton in 2015 and 2016.

FORWARD POWER

Senior forward Pablo Rivas was named Most Outstanding Performer of the 2018 MEAC Tournament, and redshirt junior Raasean Davis joined him on the All-Tournament Team. Head coach LeVelle Moton also gained recognition as the Most Outstanding Coach of the tourney. Rivas averaged 15.3 points and 6.0 rebounds per game, and swatted three shots with five steals over four games, and Davis averaged a double-double with 12.5 points and 12.3 rebounds per contest.

20-22-22

Raasean Davis made an impact in NCCU's quarterfinal win over Savannah State when he pulled down 20 rebounds, the first 20-rebound performance since David Covington brought down 21 boards against Wingate on Dec. 5, 2001. Davis had nine offensive rebounds and 11 defensive boards, and went on to score 22 points by going 10-for-13 from the floor in the semifinal against Morgan State. Not to be outdone, Pablo Rivas poured in 22 points in the championship game against Hampton.

FREE THROWS WIN BALLGAMES

Pablo Rivas has been exceptionally accurate from the free throw line recently, as he went 11-for-11 from the charity stripe during the MEAC Tournament, and has made his last 14 attempts. This streak began in the second half at South Carolina State on Feb. 24. Rivas leads the Eagles in free-throw shooting, knocking down 76.4 percent of his attempts.

NCAA STATS TOP-25

NCCU as a team is ranked top-25 in the NCAA Division-I in total assists with 535, and total rebounds with 1,293. Individually, Raasean Davis is ranked fifth in the nation in field-goal percentage at 66.7 percent, and Perkins falls just outside the top-25 in total assists with 184 to rank 27th.

ALL-MEAC TRIO

For the second consecutive year, North Carolina Central University has had multiple players earn Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference honors as Raasean Davis was named Second Team, and both Reggie Gardner, Jr. and Jordan Perkins were named All-Rookie. Davis led the Eagles in scoring with 15.4 points and finished ninth in the MEAC in that category, along with eight double-doubles. Gardner finished the regular season eighth in threes made per game at a rate of 2.2 with 67 made during his freshman campaign along with 11.0 points per game. Perkins ran the point and finished third in the league with 5.4 assists per game and was second with a 2.0 assist-to-turnover ratio.

TRIPLE DOUBLE-DOUBLE

NCCU accomplished a rare feat of having three players record a double-double on the road at Bethune-Cookman on Feb. 12. Jordan Perkins recorded his first career double-double in that game with 17 points and a game-high 10 assists, and Raasean Davis collected a game-high 26 points with 11 rebounds. Pablo Rivas completed the trio with 21 points and 10 rebounds.

FREE BASKETBALL

NCCU played an overtime game for the first time since the 2015-16 season when the Eagles fell 84-78 at Howard. Under Moton, the Eagles are 7-4 in games that go to an extra frame, and 3-3 against MEAC opponents in overtime.

NCCU vs SWAC

The Southwestern Athletic Conference has 10 member institutions, and while NCCU has only played four teams in the Division I era, it holds a 4-2 record against the conference. Below is a recap of NCCU's matchups with the conference.

NEXT MAN UP

NCCU is one of less than 10 schools that returns zero starters from its previous season. The Eagles bring back the second-fewest starts in the nation with 11, all coming from C.J. Wiggins, and the third-fewest total minutes with 862, 626 of which came from Pablo Rivas.

CRASHING THE BOARDS

NCCU pulled down the most rebounds in the Division-I era against Warren Wilson when the Eagles swept up 66 rebounds. The Eagles topped the mark of 57 set against Barber-Scotia on Dec. 17, 2014. This season, the Eagles also pulled down 58 boards against Christendom on Dec. 30.

COMING UP ACES

NCCU currently leads the MEAC in four categories after a strong showing during the non-conference schedule. The Eagles are tops in the league in points allowed per game (69.4), field goal percentage (46.6), rebounding margin (+5.0), and rebounds allowed per game (33.1).

ROOKIE RANKING

Freshmen Reggie Gardner, Jr. and Jordan Perkins have found their way into the starting lineup, and are the first freshmen to start for the Eagles since C.J. Wiggins during the 2015-16 season. Gardner and Perkins are both statistically ranked within the MEAC, as well. Gardner is top-30 in scoring with an average of 11.1 points per game and is a volume shooter from the perimeter, ranking eighth in threes per game with 2.2. Perkins has taken on his role as a point guard and is second in the league in assists with 5.4 per outing and is second in assist-to-turnover ratio with a positive 2.0.

Larry McKnight, Jr. was highly efficient from the floor at Marshall as he was 7-for-7 from the field, 3-3 from the arc and 2-2 from the free throw line for 19 points. Dominique Reid reached the same mark as well against Howard, going 7-for-7 from the floor and 2-for-2 from the charity stripe for 16 points. Last season, senior forward Pablo Rivas matched a rare feat of former Eagle Dominique Sutton against Western Carolina on Nov. 16, as he went 7-for-7 from the floor and 2-for-2 from the free throw line for 18 points and nine rebounds. McKnight, Reid, and Rivas are in rare company now, joining Emmanuel Chapman as the only other Eagles to shoot 100 percent from the floor with a spotless three-point percentage as well. Rivas shot 100 percent from the floor a second time at Missouri, but missed one free throw for 16 points and six rebounds (6-6 FG, 4-5 FT).

SLIPPERY ROCK

The Eagles were bitten by the turnover bug as they lost the rock 26 times at Evansville, the most since Jan. 15, 2010 during the Division I transition when the Eagles turned the ball over 27 times against Tennessee Temple.

-NCCU went 11-2 at McDougald-McLendon Arena, securing its eighth consecutive winning season at home.

- The Eagles captured their third MEAC Regular Season title and made their second NCAA Tournament appearance after going 13-3 in league play.

-NCCU once again was one of the best defensive teams in the league, allowing just 63.5 points per game to lead the league, and was 11th in the nation in field goal percentage allowed at 39.3 percent.

The last MEAC team to beat NCCU in Durham was Savannah State on Feb. 11, 2012 (67-57) before Howard ended the streak on Dec. 7, 2015 (71-69). NCCU defeated 26 consecutive conference opponents during the run.

Eagles Hold Off Morgan State to Advance to MEAC Championship

NORFOLK, Va. – North Carolina Central University had to weather a second-half storm from Morgan State as the Bears made a late run, but the Eagles held on for a 79-70 win to advance to a second-consecutive MEAC Championship appearance on Friday, March 9 at Scope Arena.

NCCU (18-15) made it a point to work the ball inside to Raasean Davis (Chicago, Ill.) early and often, and he collected 15 points in the first half. MSU (13-19) scored first in the contest and tied the game a few times, but the Eagles grabbed a lead with 7:19 to go in the first half, and eventually held it for the rest of the game.

The first 20 minutes set the stage for a duel between Davis and Tiwan Kendley (Harlem, N.Y.) as Kendley matched Davis's 15 points with 13 of his own, but the Eagles as a team had a 35-29 lead after 20 minutes.

NCCU started the second half on an 8-2 run, and eventually led MSU by as many as 16, which set up a necessary cushion for the later stages. In the middle part of the second half, the Bears put together a 16-6 run and trimmed the deficit to just six points which set up a tense final nine minutes of play.

The Eagles got a few timely buckets in the closing stages, including a three-pointer from Zacarry Douglas (Bowie, Md.) and a jumper and a pair of free throws from C.J. Wiggins (Richmond, Va.) to keep the lead and finish the game out.

Davis finished with 22 points and 11 rebounds for NCCU for his second consecutive double-double in back-to-back nights, and Pablo Rivas (Colón, Panama) followed with 16 points. Raekwon Harney (Winston-Salem, N.C.) dished out a game-high seven assists, and Jordan Perkins (Greensboro, N.C.) handed out five assists along with nine points.

Kendley was the leading man for MSU as he finished with a game-high 30 points, and both Martez Cameron (Chicago, Ill.) and David Syfax (Detroit, Mich.) collected 11 points.

Eagles Win Second Consecutive MEAC Tournament Championship

NORFOLK, Va. – North Carolina Central University is heading back to the NCAA Tournament after knocking off top-seeded Hampton, 71-63 in a hard-fought MEAC Championship game at Scope Arena in Norfolk, Virginia.

This is NCCU's (19-15) third MEAC Tournament Championship in the past five years, and the Eagles are now 3-0 in MEAC Championship games.

The Eagles and Hampton (17-15) went back-and-forth in the first half, and NCCU was propelled by Pablo Rivas (Colón, Panama) who put in 11 points. However, Malique Trent-Street (Portsmouth, Va.) hit a long-range three-pointer right before the end of the half to give the Pirates a 28-27 advantage at the half.

NCCU started the second half on an 11-2 run, and pulled ahead of Hampton 38-30 on some big treys from John Guerra (Cary, N.C.) and Rivas. Hampton immediately shrunk the lead, and eventually went on an 8-0 run to take a one-point lead at 53-52 with 7:30 remaining.

The game stayed locked together for the next three minutes, but then the Eagles ripped off an 11-0 run in the last minute-and-a-half to create enough space to seal the victory.

Rivas chipped in a game-high 22 points with five rebounds, and Guerra provided a big spark with 12 points and five rebounds. Jordan Perkins (Greensboro, N.C.) dished out a game-high nine assists with 13 points.

Hampton was led by Trent-Street (Portsmouth, Va.) who put in 15 points, and both Kalin Fisher (Chicago, Ill.) and Akim Mitchell (Charlotte, N.C.) put in 11.

Raasean Davis (Chicago, Ill.) and Rivas were both named to the All-Tournament team, and Rivas was named Most Outstanding Performer. NCCU head coach LeVelle Moton was also named Most Outstanding Coach.

the school's third all-time leading scorer with 1,714 points during his historic hardwood career as an Eagle from 1992-96, earning the nickname "Poetry 'n Moton."

During his junior and senior seasons, Moton was voted All-CIAA First Team, NCAA Division II South Atlantic All-Region First Team and NCAA Division II All-America Honorable Mention. He was named the 1996 CIAA [Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association] Men's Basketball Player of the Year and was inducted into the NCCU Athletic Hall of Fame in 2004.

Among NCCU's all-time career leaders, Moton ranks first in 3-point field goals made (213 of 529), third in scoring (1,714 points), fourth in free throws made (363 of 467), fifth in assists (278), eighth in field goals made (569 of 1,159), 10th in scoring average (16.6 points per game), and 11th in steals (110).

As a junior (1994-95), he topped the CIAA and was No. 16 in NCAA Division II in scoring with an average of 23.5 points per game. His 87 made three-point field goals that year remains the school's single-season record.

As a senior (1995-96), he placed second in the CIAA with 21.3 points per game and ranked among the conference's top 10 statistical leaders in assists, free throw percentage and 3-point field goal percentage.

Moton played on three CIAA Southern Division Championship teams and made two trips to the NCAA playoffs, including an NCAA Division II South Atlantic Regional Championship title in 1993.

After NCCU, Moton played four years of professional basketball in Indonesia (1996-97) and Israel (1998-99). Throughout his professional playing career, Moton averaged 25.0 points per contest, and dished out a little more than five assists per game as a pro.

He was head coach at West Millbrook Middle School for three seasons (2001-04) before taking over the Sanderson boys basketball program in 2004.

Moton is a 1992 graduate of Enloe High School in Raleigh, N.C., where he was named Cap5 Player of the Year as a senior.

In December of 2013, Moton received his Master's degree in Special Education with a focus on Learning Disabilities.

He and his wife, Bridget, married on June 28, 2008. They have two children Brooke and LeVelle Jr.

On March 25, 2009, arguably one of the greatest players in school history was elevated from Assistant Coach to the position of Head Coach, becoming the 17th to be named in that spot in the program's history.

During the 2016-17 season Moton led the Eagles to a 25-9 overall record and a 13-3 MEAC mark, and he joined rare company with John B. McLendon as the only coaches with four 20-win seasons at NCCU. NCCU captured its third MEAC regular-season championship and second MEAC Tournament championship within a four year span to make its second Division-I NCAA Tournament appearance. The Eagles also made history with their first win over an SEC opponent with a wire-to-wire 62-52 win at Missouri. NCCU went on a 13-game win streak during conference play, the second-longest win streak in the Division I era. The Eagles continued to pride itself on defense by being second in the nation in three-point defense, allowing just 29.0 percent of made attempts. NCCU was also top-10 in field goal percentage defense (39.1), top-25 in scoring defense (63.4 points per game) and top-15 in scoring margin (11.7 points per game).

Close to 25 years after the magical run of the 1989 NCAA Division II National Championship team, and just 10 days shy of the fifth anniversary of the day of his official hiring, NCCU soared to its first MEAC Tournament Championship on March 15, 2014 following its 71-62 victory over Morgan State in front of a near-capacity crowd inside the Norfolk Scope Arena. The 2013-14 Eagles tied a school record in wins (28), won the most games in a season for any squad in MEAC history, and was the lowest seed for any league champion in the NCAA Tournament as the maroon and gray earned a 14-seed in the East Region. Moton's squad finished 15-1 in conference play earning the school's first Division I regular season title and won 20 straight contests, which set a new NCAA Division I level record for the program.

The following year, his sixth season as head coach at NCCU, Moton guided the 2014-15 Eagles to a 25-8 overall record, including a 19-3 mark during the final three-and-a-half months, as well as the school's first appearance in the National Invitation Tournament. The 2014-15 squad made history by becoming the first men's basketball team in school history to post an unbeaten regular-season conference record at 16-0 to repeat as MEAC regular-season champions. The Eagles were among the top five defenses in Division I, ranking second in field goal percentage defense (behind Kentucky), fourth in three-point field goal percentage defense and fifth in scoring defense. NCCU completed the campaign by extending the second-longest home win streak in Division I at 35 victories in-a-row (behind Arizona).

Moton joined hall of fame coach John McLendon and national championship coach Michael Bernard as the only coaches in NCCU men's basketball history to lead the Eagles to three straight 20-win seasons. As a credit to the program's recent success, NCCU boasts the best regular-season conference record during the last three seasons at 46-2, a winning percentage of .958.

With the rings of a champion came the accolades as Moton earned MEAC Coach of the Year honors, MEAC Tournament's Most Outstanding Coach award, and was named the BoxtoRow.com HBCU National Coach of the Year, while earning finalist spots in the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year Award (Top-Mid-Major Coach), and the Top Minority Coach honor, the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Award.

The maroon and gray's second season in the MEAC, Moton's fourth, was the coming out party for the program. For the first time at the NCAA Division I level, the Eagles won 20 games finishing the year 22-9, and went 15-1 in conference play to earn the No. 2 seed in the conference tournament. Moton earned national praise by being named a finalist for the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Award, and the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year Award, along with Co-Coach of the Year in the MEAC by CollegeInsider.com.

In his third season in charge of NCCU, Moton took his team to a place not since seen since the 2004-05 season when the Eagles finished with a winning record (17-15) and were seeded fifth in their first MEAC Tournament at the Division I level.

His second year at the helm his squad showed the Eagle Nation how bright the future was as his squad racked up 15 wins and recorded the first non-losing season in nearly six years. He earned NCAA Division I Independent Coach of the Year honors.

He initially returned to his alma mater as assistant men's basketball coach in July 2007.

The Hall-of-Famer joined the NCCU staff after serving as head boys basketball coach at Sanderson High School in his hometown of Raleigh, N.C. During his three-year tenure (2004-07) at Sanderson, Moton led the Spartans to an overall record of 59-25, while winning back-to-back Cap-7 tournament championships in 2006 and 2007.

A 1996 graduate of NCCU with a bachelor's degree in recreation administration, Moton became
